SECSTATE PASS TO DEPT INT/SEC INTERIOR/DASTA/OSN

(MARIANAS MEETING)

SAIPAN, APRIL 21 (MNS)---THE MEMBERS OF THE MARIANAS DELEGATION TO THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA AND OTHER DISTRICT POLITICAL LEADERS HELD A CLOSED MEETING THIS WEEK WITH AMBASSADOR FRANKLIN HAYDN WILLIAMS, ACCORDING TO A NEWS REPORT FROM RADIO STATION KJQR ON SAIPAN. THE MEETING RESULTED IN A TENTATIVE PROPOSAL REGARDING THE NEXT STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN

THE SEPARATE STATUS NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE MARIANAS.

ACCORDING TO REPRESENTATIVE HERMAN GUERRERO, AMBASSADOR WILLIAMS SUGGESTED THAT THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR SETTING UP THE MACHINERY FOR THE NEGOTIATIONS RESTS WITH THE MARIANAS. GUERRERO TOLD KJQR THAT A MARIANAS STATUS COMMISSION IS TO BE ESTABLISHED, PROBABLY THROUGH LEGISLATION BY THE DISTRICT LEGISLATURE AT ITS NEXT SESSION IN AUGUST. THIS COMMISSION, GUERRERO SAID, WILL BE FULLY REPRESENTATIVE OF ALL SEGMENTS OF THE MARIANAS COMMUNITY, INCLUDING BOTH MAJOR POLITICAL PARTIES, COMMUNITY GROUPS, AND BUSINESS.

BEYOND ESTABLISHMENT OF THIS COMMISSION, NO TIMETABLE FOR THE NEGOTIATIONS WAS DISCUSSED. THE MARIANAS POLITICAL LEADERS INDICATED TO AMBASSADOR WILLIAMS THAT THE MARIANAS DISTRICT IS READY TO MERGE WITH THE U.S. JUST AS SOON AS AGREEMENT CAN BE REACHED. WILLIAMS EXPRESSED THANKS FOR THE SINCERITY OF THE MARIANAS APPROACH, AND THEIR EXPRESSED DESIRE TO BE A PART OF THE UNITED STATES.

ALTHOUGH THERE WAS NO INDICATION WHETHER IT WAS MENTIONED DURING THE MEETING, U.S. OFFICIALS HAVE POINTED OUT AT OTHER

TIMES THAT THE TALKS WITH THE MARIANAS ON FUTURE STATUS WILL RUN CONCURRENTLY WITH THE STATUS NEGOTIATIONS INVOLVING THE OTHER FIVE DISTRICTS. IN OTHER WORDS, SAID ONE OFFICIAL, THE TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENT, WHEN IT ENDS, WILL END FOR ALL SIX DISTRICT AT THE SAME TIME.

(INDEPENDENCE STATEMENT)
SAIPAN, APRIL 21, (MNS)---THE MICRONESIAN INDEPENDENCE COALITION, A GROUP OF MEMBERS OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA WHO FAVOR COMPLETE INDEPENDENCE FOR MICRONESIA, HAS ISSUED A STATEMENT IN RESPONSE TO THE RECENT FOURTH ROUND OF FUTURE STATUS NEGOTIATIONS IN PALAU. THE STATEMENT WAS RELEASED ON SAIPAN BY REPRESENTATIVE HANS WILLIANDER OF TRUK, WHO IS SPOKESMAN FOR THE GROUP.

THE TEXT OF THE STATEMENT IS AS FOLLOWS:

"I AM HAPPY TO INFORM MEMBERS OF THE COALITION, THE CHIEFS AND THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA THAT THE U.S. DELEGATION AT LAST RELUCTANTLY AGREED TO RECOGNIZE THE FOUR BASIC PRINCIPLES AND LEGAL RIGHTS OF THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA.

"FROM A JOINT COMMUNIQUE (KOM-MEW-NIH-KAY') ISSUED BY BOTH SIDES ON APRIL 14, AND A SUPPLEMENTARY PRESS RELEASE BY

THE MICRONESIAN DELEGATION ALONE...IT APPEARS THAT SOME MAJOR DISAGREEMENTS STILL REMAIN. THESE ARE IN THE AREAS OF MICRONESIAN SOVERIGNTY AND FOREIGN AFFAIRS. ON SOVEREIGNTY THE U.S. DELEGATION ARGUED THAT IT WILL BE EXERCISED WHEN THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA VOTE TO ACCEPT THE COMPACT. IN RESPECT TO FOREIGN AFFAIRS, THE U.S. DEMANDED FULL CONTROL. " I WISH TO REPEAT THAT THE COALITION FULLY SUPPORTS THE BASIC PRINCIPLE THAT SOVEREIGNTY RESIDES IN THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA AND THEIR DULY CONSTITUTED GOVERNMENT. ON FOREIGN AFFAIRS THE COALITION HOLDS THAT THE MICRONESIAN STATE WILL RETAIN COMPLETE CONTROL. THE MICRONESIAN STATE WILL RETAIN THE POWER TO VETO ANY ACTION TAKEN ON ITS BEHALF BY THE UNITED STATES.

"IT APPEARS TO ME," THE STATEMENT BY WILLIANDER CONTINUES, "THAT THERE WAS NO SERIOUS AND LENGTHY DISCUSSION REGARDING MILITARY ACTIVITIES IN MICRONESIA BETWEEN THE TWO DELEGATIONS. THE COALITION MAINTAINS THAT SURVIVAL OF MICRONESIA AS A PEOPLE AND A STATE IS ONLY GUARANTEED BY ABSENCE OF WAR ON ITS SHORES IN THE FUTURE. WE ARE CONSTANTLY REMINDED OF THE SUFFERINGS INFLICTED UPON THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA DURING

WORLD WAR TWO. THE COALITION FEELS THAT STEPS SHOULD BE
TAKEN TO INSURE THAT NO MICRONESIAN BE CAUGHT IN ANOTHER

U.S. GOVERNMENT TO CEASE ALL ITS MILITARY ACTIVITIES IN

THE INDEPENDENCE COALITION WILL DRAW ALL OF ITS SUPPORTERS BE-
HIND THE MICRONESIAN DELEGATION, TO ACHIEVE A NEW STATUS FOR
THE PEOPLE AND GOVERNMENT OF MICRONESIA."

THIS WAS THE STATEMENT OF HANS WILIANDER, WHO IS A SPOKE-
SMAN FOR THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA'S INDEPENDENCE COALITION.
THE COALITION CLAIMS THE SUPPORT OF MORE THAN A DOZEN MEMBERS OF
THE CONGRESS, WITH MOST OF ITS STRENGTH IN THE TRUK DELEGATION.

ALTHOUGH STILL CALLED THE INDEPENDENCE COALITION, THE
GROUP HAS LATELY BEEN EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE MICRONESIAN
POSITION OF FREE ASSOCIATION BASED ON THE FOUR BASIC
PRINCIPLES OUTLINED IN THE 1970 STATUS DELEGATION REPORT.

CONFERENCE THIS YEAR WAS TIMED TO COINCIDE WITH THE INCREASE
IN POWER TO TEN THOUSAND WATTS OF THE PONAPE BROADCAST STATION,

IN A SPECIAL BROADCAST WEDNESDAY (APRIL 19), THE NEW,
POWERFUL TRANSMITTER WAS INAUGURATED WITH REMARKS BROADCAST

ADMINISTRATOR J. BOYD MACKENZIE. TRUST TERRITORY BROADCAST
CHIEF GEORGE CALLISON SAID THE POWER INCREASE AT WSZD IS THE

KATHERINE KESOLEI OF PALAU, TO WORK TOWARD A DEGREE IN ARTS AND SCIENCES; AND ROSEMARY MERSAI, ALSO OF PALAU, TO WORK TOWARD A MASTER DEGREE IN ECONOMICS. ALTERNATES HAVE ALSO BEEN SELECTED IN THE EVENT THESE FOUR PEOPLE CANNOT ACCEPT THEIR SCHOLARSHIPS.
