(MARIANAS REAFFIRMCS POSITION)

SAIPAN, APRIL 26, (MNS) - + - THE POLITICAL LEADERS OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT HAVE OFFICIALLY INFORMED THE U.S. GOVERNMENT OF THEIR INTENTION TO ESTABLISH A MARIANAS POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF NEGOTIATING THE DISTRICT'S FUTURE STATUS.

THE NOTIFICATION CAME IN A LETTER TO AMBASSADOR FRANKLIN HAYDN

PAGE THREE RUHGSAA4939 UNCLAS WILLTAMS, SIGNED BY NEARLY ALL OF THE TOP POLITICAL LEADERS OF THE MARIANAS DISTRICT.

THE LETTER WAS WRITTEN FOLLOWING MEETINGS HELD LAST WEEK BETWEEN AMBASSADOR WILLIAMS AND THE POLITICAL LEADERS ON SAIPAN. THE LETTER INDICATES THAT THE LEADERSHIP HAS DETERMINED THROUGH A SERIES OF MEETINGS THROUGHOUT THE DISTRICT THAT THE DESIRE OF THE PEOPLE THE MARIANAS TO UNITE WITH THE U.S. IS AS STRONG AS EVER. LETTER STATES:

"IN THE EVENT THAT THERE IS ANY DOUBT THAT THIS STATEMENT OF POSITION IS SUPPORTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT? WE, THE ELECTED LEADERS AND OFFICIALS OF OUR DISTRICT, WANT THE RECORD TO SHOW THAT THIS STATEMENT OF POSITION IS FULLY SUPPORTED AND ENDORSED BY US AND BY THE PEOPLE WHOM WE REPRESENT.

"IN THE SEVERAL MEETINGS HELD WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF VILLAGES? MUNICIPALITIES, AND DISTRICT, SUPPORT OF THE STATEMENT OF POSITION WAS UNANIMOUSLY REAFFIRMED. AS IT WAS IN THE PLEBISCITES THAT WERE HELD IN 1961, 1963, AND 1969. SO YOU CAN SEE THAT THE DESTRE OF THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT TO BECOME A PERMANENT PART OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IS FUNDAMENTAL AND HAS EXISTED OVER A NUMBER OF YEARS.

WE HAVE GROWN TO APPRECIATE AND CHERISH THE IDEALS OF DEMOCRACY AND WANT TO JOIN THE AMERICAN POLITICAL FAMILY.

"WE PLEDGE TO YOU AND YOUR GOVERNMENT OUR LOYALTY AND DEDICATION TO THE PRINCIPLES FOR WHICH AMERICA STANDS, AND FURTHER, WE STAND! READY TO ACCEPT THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FREEDOM THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA GUARANTEES AND DEFENDS.

"IT IS, THEREFORE, OUR FIRM AND IMMEDIATE INTENTION," SAID THE LETTER, "TO FORGE AHEAD IN CREATING A POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION WHICH WILL REPRESENT THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANAS IN MATTERS REGARD. WHEN THOSE ARRANGEMENTS ARE COMPLETED, WE ING A CHANGE OF STATUS. WOULD LIKE TO OPEN FORMAL DISCUSSIONS WITH YOUR GOVERNMENT AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF EFFECTING A CLOSE POLITICAL UNION WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

"IN CLOSING, WE WISH AGAIN TO EXPRESS TO YOUR GOVERNMENT OUR DEEP AND SINCERE GRATITUDE FOR YOUR KIND UNDERSTANDING OF OUR POLIT-TICAL ASPIRATIONS, AND WISH YOU TO KNOW THAT WE STAND READY TO DO
