1. TICKETS AND ORDERS FOR MARIANAS PETITIONERS BEING SENT AIRMAIL TO SAIPAN. WE HAVE ASSUMED THAT THESE WILL BE PANGELINAN AND GUERRERO AND HAVE MADE TICKETS OUT IN THEIR NAMES. THEY WILL BE DESIGNATED CONSULTANTS TO THE DELEGATION BUT WILL HAVE NO FORMAL STATUS VIS-A-VIS TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL THAT COULD EMBARRASS THEIR CREDIBILITY AS PETITIONERS.

2. DASTA CARPENTER PLANS DISCUSS COUNCIL SESSION FURTHER WITH PANGELINAN AND GUERRERO AT HONOLULU AND WILL SUGGEST TO THEM THAT THEY REPEAT POSITION ALREADY MADE TO COUNCIL THAT MARIANAS WANT CLOSER ASSOCIATION WITH US THAN OTHER DISTRICTS. NOTE THAT FURTHER PROGRESS TO THAT END HAS BEEN MADE SINCE LAST COUNCIL MEETING AND HAS ENJOYED FULL SUPPORT OF PEOPLE OF MARIANAS, AND POINT OUT THAT UNTIL TRUSTEESHIP IS TERMINATED FOR ENTIRE TERRITORY MARIANAS WILL CONTINUE TO COOPERATE WITH OTHER DISTRICTS. 44
