(MARIANAS SPECIAL SESSION CONVENES)

SAIPAN, MAY 12, (MNS)---THE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION OF THE THIRD MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE OFFICIALLY CONVENED FRIDAY MORNING (MAY 12) WITH PRESIDENT VICENTE NO SANTOS PRESIDING ON SAIPANO

MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE HEARD BRIEF REMARKS FROM MARIANAS DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR FRANCISCO C. ADA DURING

THE OPENING DAY OF THE SESSION. DISTAD ADA SAID THAT THE FIRST
SPECIAL SESSION OF THE MARIANAS LEGISLATURE IS AN HISTORIC
OCCASION IN THAT THE LEGISLATURE WILL BE DELIBERATING ON AN
IMPORTANT PIECE OF LEGISLATION WHICH WILL DETERMINE THE ULTIMATE
SOLUTION TO THE POLITICAL STATUS QUESTION FOR THE MARIANAS. HE
SAID THAT SUCH AN IMPORTANT PIECE OF LEGISLATION WILL NOT ONLY
AFFECT THE PRESENT GENERATION. BUT GENERATIONS TO COME.

LATE FRIDAY MORNING AN ACT WAS INTRODUCED WHICHWOULD CREATE THE MARIANAS POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION, SETTING FORTH ITS POWERS AND DUTIES. THE ACT WAS REFERRED TO THE POLITICAL COMMITTEE OF THE MARIANAS LEGISLATURE, CHAIRED BY FELIPE SALAS, FOR STUDY.

ACCORDING TO THE ACT, MEMBERSHIP ON THE MARIANAS POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION WOULD CONSISTOF TWO PERSONS FROM THE MARIANAS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE: THE MARIANAS REPRESENTATIVES TO THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON FUTURE STATUS OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA: TWO PERSONS FROM ROTA, TINIAN, AND SAIPAN TO BE SELECTED BY LOCAL COUNCILS: A REPRESENTATIVE EACH FROM THE MARIANAS POPULAR AND TERRITORIAL PARTIES: A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE UNITED CAROLINIAN ASSOCIATION: AND A REPRESENTATIVE TO BE APPOINTED BY THE MARIANAS DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR FROM A LIST OF NAMES TO BE SUBMITTED BY

FROM ITS OWN MEMBERS A CHAIRMAN AND SUCH OTHER OFFICERS: AS IT MAY REQUIRE, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARIANAS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE SHALL PRESIDE AT ITS FIRST MEETING UNTIL SUCH TIME AS A CHAIRMAN CAN BE SELECTED. THE FIRST MEETING OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE CALLED WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE APPOINTMENT OF ALL MEMBERS.

UNDER THE ACT, THE COMMISSION WOULD MAKE STUDIES CONCERNING THE ISSUE OF THE FUTURE POLITICAL STATUS OF THE MARIANAS DISTRICT. THE COMMISSION MAY CONTACT AND DISCUSS THE STATUS ISSUE WITH APPROPRIATE PERSONS AND ORGANIZATIONS IN THE U.S. AND IN THE U.N. AND SOLICIT UNDERSTANDING SUPPORT OF THE POSITION OF THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANAS.

THE ACT WOULD ALSO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION TO CONDUCT DISCUSSIONS AND NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE U.S. GOVERNMENT ON THE FUTURE POLITICAL STATUS OF THE MARIANAS, PROVIDED THAT ANY AGREEMENT REACHED ON SUCH ISSUE SHALLNOT BE BINDING ON THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT UNTIL RATIFIED THROUGH A

THE ACT WOULD APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$25,000 DOLLARS TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE OF THE COMMISSION. A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE BILL IS TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED TO BE HELD NEXT WEEK ON TUESDAY, MAY 16, AT THE DISTRICT LEGISLATURE BUILDING IN SUSUPE AT 1:30 P.M. ALL SECTORS OF THE MARIANAS COMMUNITY WILL BE INVITED TO PRESENT THEIR VIEWS.

THE LEGISLATURE ALSO SAW THE INTRODUCTION OF A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY AND CONDOLENCES TO THE FAMILY OF LATE FRANCISCO BORJA KAIPAT OF PAGAN ISLAND. EARLIER IN THE MORNING SESSION, PRESIDENT SANTOS, BEFORE CALLING THE ORDER OF BUSINESS, CALLED UPON HIS LAWMAKERS TO STAND UP AND OFFER A PRAYER IN REVERENCE TO KAIPAT WHO WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE MARIANAS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE BEFORE HIS UNTIMELY DEATH.

SATPAN, MAY 12, (MNS) --- THE TRUST TERRITORY DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE WILL BE ISSUING TAX REFUNDS CHECKS TOTALING ABOUT \$300,000 DOLLARS TO ALL MICRONESIAN INCOME TAX PAYERS IN THE TRUST TERRITORY NEXT WEEK.

THE TAX REFUNDS WILL BE FOR ALL THOSE EMPLOYEES WHOSE TAX WAS WITHELD FROM THEIR WAGES BY THEIR EMPLOYERS. REFUND CHECKS FOR THOSE EMPLOYEES WHO FILED QUARTERLY INDIVIDUAL: RETURNS BECAUSE THERE WAS NO TAX WITHELD FROM THEIR WAGES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED THE FOLLOWING WEEK.

THESE REFUNDS REPRESENT THE AMOUNT OF TAX ON EACH EMPLOYEE'S WAGES UP TO \$500 DOLLARS FOR THE TAX YEAR 1971. SINCE THE TAX RATE IS 3 PERCENT, ANYONE EARNING \$500 DOLLARS OR MORE SINCE JULY 1, 1971, WILL RECEIVE A REFUND OF \$15 DOLLARS. THOSE EMPLOYEES WHO EARNED LESS THAN \$500 DOLLARS SINCE JULY 1 1971

THEY IN TURN, WILL GIVE THE CHECKS TO THEIR EMPLOYEES. ANY EMPLOYEE WHO DOES NOT RECEIVE A CHECK OR FEELS THAT THE CHECK IS NOT THE CORRECT AMOUNT SHOULD FIRST CONTACT HIS EMPLOYER. IF FURTHER INFORMATION IS DESIRED, THAT DISTRICT TAX OFFICE SHOULD BE CONTACTED. THE DISTRICT TAX OFFICES WILL BE HAPPY TO ASSIST ANY TAXPAYER IN ANY WAY POSSIBLE.
