FOR COORDINATING STAFF WORK FOR THE DELEGATION, WHICH CONSISTS
OF FIVE MEMBERS, TWO SENATORS AND THREE REPRESENTATIVES.

SAIPAN, MAY 26 (MNS)---THE OFFICE OF THE MARIANAS DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR HAS FORWARDED A PROPOSAL AND CHARTER AGREEMENT TO THE OFFICE OF THE HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR HIS CONSIDERATION CONCERNING THE CHARTERING OF A JAPANESE UNDERWATER VEHICLE.

ACCORDING TO A KJQR RADIO NEWS STORY, THE SUBMERSIBLE VEHICLE, KNOWN AS MARK TEN, WILL ALLOW PERSONS INSIDE TO VIEW THE FASCINATING UNDERWATER SCENERY OF THE TROPICAL OCEAN. THE MARIANAS DISTAD'S OFFICE FEELS IT WOULD BE AN ADDED ATTRACTION FOR THE EVER INCREASING NUMBER OF TOURISTS COMING INTO THE MARIANAS.

DISTAD ADA INDICATED THAT THE MARIANAS WATERS ARE CLEAR ENOUGH TO PERMIT EXCELLENT VISIBILITY OF THE BEAUTIFUL UNDERWATER WORLD. HE ALSO NOTED THAT SAIPAN IS AN ESTABLISHED NAME FOR THE TOURIST INDUSTRY AND IS PREPARING TO MEET THE DEMANDS FOR TOURIST FACILITIES AND PROVIDE SERVICES FOR THE CONVENIENCES OF THE CUSTOMERS.
