COMTWELVE FOR AMBASSADOR WILLIAMS SECSTATE PASS TO DEPT INT/SEC INTERIOR/DASTA OSN (SPECIAL SESSION REQUEST)

SAIPAN, JUNE 6, (MNS) --- THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA LEADERSHIP HAS FORMALLY ASKED HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON TO CALL A SPECIAL SESSION THIS SUMMER. THE REQUEST WAS EXPECTED, SINCE SUCH A SESSION WAS TENTATIVELY AGREED UPON DURING A LEADERSHIP MEETING LATE IN APRIL IN MAJURO, AND IN SUBSEQUENT DISCUSSIONS IN HONOLULU INVOLVING SENATE PRESIDENT AMATA KABUA, HOUSE SPEAKER BETHWEL HENRY, AND THE HICOM.

THE REQUEST ASKS THAT THE SESSION BE CALLED FOR PONAPE DISTRICT, BEGINNING MONDAY, AUGUST 14, AND RUNNING FOR NOT MORE THAN 20 CALENDAR DAYS. THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE SESSION, IF IT IS CALLED, WOULD BE TO CONSIDER MICRONESIA'S FUTURE POLITICAL STATUS AND LEGISLATION RELATED TO THAT SUBJECT. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT ANOTHER ROUND OF STATUS TALKS, IN WASHINGTON IN JULY, WOULD PROVIDE THE CONGRESS WITH SOME SPECIFIC MATTERS TO CONSIDER ON THE SUBJECT OF STATUS. SENATOR LAZARUS SALII OF PALAU, CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON FUTURE STATUS, SAID LAST MONTH THAT HE HOPES A DRAFT COMPACT OF ASSOCIATION WILL BE READY FOR PRESENTATION TO THE CONGRESS BY THE TIME OF THE SPECIAL SESSION.

THE CONGRESS REQUEST ALSO ASKS FOR THE INCLUSION IN THE "CALL" OF SEVERAL OTHER AREAS OF LEGISLATION, INCLUDING TAXATION MATTERS, LOW COST HOUSING, DISASTER RELIEF, REAPPORTIONMENT AND LEGISLATION RELATING TO BROADCASTING. WHETHER ALL, OR ANY, OF THESE AREAS WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE SPECIAL SESSION CALL IS UP TO THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

UNDER TERMS OF SECRETARIAL ORDER 2918, ONLY THE HICOM CAN CALL FOR A SPECIAL SESSION, AND HE CAN SPECIFY BOTH THE TIME AND LOCATION OF THAT SESSION, AND THE MATTERS TO BE CONSIDERED. DURING A SPECIAL

CALL CAN BE PART OF THE LEGISLATIVE CALENDAR, PLUS MATTERS
WHICH MAY BE ADDED IN ANY SPECIAL MESSAGE FROM THE HICOM WHILE
THE CONGRESS IS IN SESSION.

(COMMITTEE TO VISIT JAPAN)

SAIPAN, JUNE 6 (MNS) --- THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA'S SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE RONGELAP AND UTIRIK WILL VISIT JAPAN THIS MONTH. WORD OF THE VISIT WAS RECEIVED FROM MARIANAS SENATOR GLYMPIO T. BORJA, THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

SENATOR BORJA SAID THE PURPOSE OF THE VISIT WILL BE PRIMARILY TO VISIT HIROSHIMA AND NAGASAKI, TO OBSERVE THE PEOPLE THERE WHO WERE AFFECTED BY THE ATOMIC EXPLOSIONS THAT ENDED WORLD WAR TWO AND TO VISIT THE TREATMENT FACILITIES FOR THEM. HE S'ID THE COMMITTEE WILL BE INTERESTED IN SEEING THE TYPE OF TREATMENT THESE PEOPLE ARE RECEIVING, THE NATURE OF THE MEDICAL PROBLEMS

SAIPAN, JUNE 6 (MNS) ===IN ANTICIPATION OF THE NEXT CONGRESS OF MICPONESIA GENERAL ELECTION, WHICH WILL BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 7 OF THIS YEAR, THE TRUST TERRITORY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS HAS BEGUN TO DISTRIBUTE REGULATIONS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE ELECTION.

THE REGULATIONS INCLUDE INFORMATION ON REGISTRATION, ABSENTEE VOTING, AND THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION. COPIES HAVE BEEN PROVIDED TO ALL DISTRICTS FOR WIDE DISSEMINATION AND PUBLICITY PRIOR TO THE ELECTION, IN ORDER THAT ALL VOTERS IN MICRONESIA WILL BE AWARE OF BOTH THEIR RIGHT TO VOTE AND THE PROCEDURE THEY MUST FOLLOW IN ORDER TO BE ABLE TO EXERCISE THAT RIGHT.

ALL CITIZENS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE WHO ARE EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER: WHO HAVE FULFILLED THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION, AND WHO ARE PROPERLY REGISTERED: AND WHO ARE NOT CURRENTLY UNDER A JUDGEMENT OF MENTAL INCOMPETENCY OR INSANITY, OR UNDER PARTLE, PROBATION, OR SENTENCE FOR ANY FELONY. THE DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IS SET BY LAW AT 30 DAYS

BEFORE THE GENERAL ELECTION, MEANING THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR THIS YEAR'S CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA ELECTION WILL BE OCTOBER 8.

IN ORDER TO BE REGISTERED, A PERSON MUST MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS, MUST HAVE RESIDED IN THE TERRITORY FOR NINE MONTHS, AND IN THE F. ZCTION DISTRICT FOR THREE MONTHS PRECEDING THE DATE OF REGISTRATION REGISTRATION.

TEMPORARY ABSENCES FOR SCHOOL, BUSINESS OR THE LIKE DURING THAT PERIOD ARE PERMITTED. ALL VOTERS MUST REGISTER WITHIN THE TERRITORY, EXCEPT FULL-TIME STUDENTS. THE LAW STATES THAT REGISTRATION OF

VOTERS OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT MUST TAKE PLACE WITHIN THAT
DISTRICT. HOWEVER, VOTERS H-O HAVE REGISTERED IN THE PAST ARE NOT
REQUIRED TO REGISTER AGAIN EXCEPT IN CASE OF CHANGE OF NAME OR
RESIDENCE OF AN INTERVENING DISQUALIFICATION.

PROVISIONS OF THE FLECTION REGULATIONS PROVIDE FOR ABSENTEE VOTING, AND VOTERS INTERESTED IN THIS PROCEDURE SHOULD CONTACT THEIR DISTRICT ELECTION COMMISSIONER OR DISTAD FOR FURTHER INFORMATION. THE OFFICE EACH DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR CAN ALSO PROVIDE OTHER ELECTION AND VOTING INFORMATION.

WHEN THE VOTERS GO TO THE POLLS ON NOVEMBER 7, THEY WILL BE SELECTING ALL 21 MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND HALF OF THE MEMBERSHIP, OR SIX, SENATORS. THE SENATORS WHOSE TERMS OF OFFICE THIS YEAR ARE SENATOR OLYMPIO BORJA OF THE MARIANAS: SENATOR ISAAC LANWI OF THE MARSHALLS: SENATOR LAZARUS SALII OF PALAU: SENATOR BAILEY OLTER OF PONAPE: SENATOR TOSIKO NAKAYAMW OF TRUK: AND SENATOR RAFEL MOONFEL OF YAP. IT IS NOT KNOWN JUST HOW MANY OF THE INCUMBENT MEMBERS OF BOTH THE HOUSE AND SENATE WILL RUN FOR RE-ELECTION, BUT ON THE BASIS OF PAST EXPERIENCE IT SEEMS LIKELY THAT THE MAJORITY OF THEM WILL SEEK ANOTHER TERM.

INOTE TO EDITORS AND NEW DIRECTORS: IN THE MICRONESIAN NEWS SERVICE DISPATCH FOR MAY 31, THE STORY SLUGGED TRANSPAC RESPONDS, WE REPORTED BASED ON INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM TRANSPAC THAT ONLY ONE VOYAGE OF A NAUPU SHIP HAS BEEN MADE TO THE TRUST TERRITORY. WE HAVE SUBSEQUENTLY LEARNED THAT THIS INFORMATION WAS INCORRECT, AND THAT AT LEAST THREE AND POSSIPLY FOUR VOYAGES HAVE BEEN MADE TO AND FROM MÂJURO BY THE NAURU VESSEL. IF YOU HAVE MADE USE OF THIS STORY IN A PUBLICATION, YOU MIGHT WISH TO CORRECT THIS INFORMATION.)
