(PLANE SINKS IN MARSHALLS)

MAJURO, AUG. 2, (MNS)--- FOUR PERSONS ESCAPED SERIOUS INJURY THIS WEEK WHEN A LAGOON AVIATION GRUMMAN WIDGEON SEAPLANE SANK UPON LANDING IN THE LAGOON AT ARNO ATOLL, IN THE MARSHALL ISLANDS.

ACCORDING TO A REPORT FROM THE MARSHALL ISLANDS PUBLIC AFFAIRS OFFICE, THE PLANE WENT DOWN IN 120 FEET OF WATER ABOUT 600 YARDS FROM SHORE. ARNO IS LOCATED ABOUT 35 MILES

"IT LOOKED AS IF THE NOSE OF THE AIRCRAFT COLLAPSED SECONDS AFTER AN OTHERWISE PERFECTLY NORMAL LANDING," SAID ARNO CAPTAIN EDWARD BAILEY, THE OFFICER-IN-CHARGE OF THE ARNO CIVIC ACTION TEAM. CAPTAIN BAILEY WAS ONE OF THE PASSENGERS ON THE PLANE. OTHERS WERE MARSHALLS LAND MANAGEMENT OFFICER LISTER DEBRUM AND ARNO LANDOWNER OBED LATRIK. THE PILOT OF THE PLANE WAS DAVID BENWAY.

"IT WAS SORT OF A MAD SCRAMBLE TO GET OUT AS THE PLANE WAS SINKING NOSE FIRST," CAPTAIN BAILEY RELATED. "BUT ALL HANDS WERE OUT OF THE PLANE AND THERE WAS SUFFICIENT TIME TO INFLATE THE LIFE RAFT BEFORE THE AIRCRAFT WENT UNDER," HE SAID.

"WE MADE A LOW PASS OVER TO CHECK THE WATER AND WIND CONDITIONS BEFORE WE CAME IN TO LAND," PILOT BENWAY TOLD MNS. "WITH THE NORTHWESTERLY WINDS AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT, THE LAGOON WAS DEAD CALM EXCEPT FOR LIGHT GROUND SWELLS. UPON TOUCHDOWN, THE AIRCRAFT WAS IN PERFECT ATTITUDE WITH LOW AIR SPEED, BUT WHEN WE REACHED THE SECOND SWELL SHE JUST OPENED UP LIKE A SARDINE CAN. BY THE THIRD SWELL, THE FRONT SECTION WAS ALREADY FULL OF WATER," BENWAY SAID.

ARE TO BE UNDERTAKEN THERE. BECAUSE THE ARNO RADIO WAS OUT OF ORDER, WORD OF THE ACCIDENT DID NOT REACH THE MAJURO DISTRICT CENTER UNTIL LATE EVENING MONDAY (JULY 31). THE ACCIDENT OCCURED AT ABOUT 8:30 A.M. THE PILOT AND HIS PASSENGERS WERE RETURNED TO MAJURO BY BOAT.

"WE ARE RELIEVED TO LEARN THERE WERE NO INJURIES, BUT ARE QUITE CONCERNED OVER THE LOSS OF THE AIRCRAFT," ACTING MARSHAL DISTAD EDMUND GILMAR COMMENTED. "MANY LIVES HAVE BEEN SAVED UTILIZING THE SERVICES OF LAGOON AVIATION FOR MEDICAL EVACUATION FROM THE OUTER ISLANDS. FROM NOW ON, THIS SERVICE WILL AGAIN BE PERFORMED BY FIELD TRIP VESSEL," HE SAID.

LAGOON AVIATION OFFICIALS, WHO WERE IN THE PROCESS OF OBTAINING ANOTHER AIRCRAFT ANYWAY, TOLD MNS THAT THE LOST WIDGET WAS FULLY INSURED.

(OEO GRANT BECOMES EFFECTIVE)

SAIPAN, AUGUST 2 (MNS)---THE THIRD-YEAR FUNDING GRANT FROM THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY FOR THE MICRONESIAN LEGAL SERVICES CORPORATION HAS TAKEN EFFECT AUTOMATICALLY,

WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF TRUST TERRITORY HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON.

S THE 600,000 DOLLAR GRANT FOR THE PROGRAM YEAR BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 1972, BECAME EFFECTIVE SUNDAY (JULY 30). THIRTY DAYS AFTER IT HAD BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE HICOM FOR HIS REVIEW. THE HIGH COMMISSIONER COULD HAVE DISAPPROVED THE GRANT, OR HE COULD HAVE GIVEN IT HIS EXPRESSED APPROVAL BY SIGNING IT. INSTEAD, HE CHOSE TO TAKE NO ACTION, HOPING BY SO DOING TO EMPHASIZE THE MISGIVINGS WHICH THE IT ADMINISTRATION HAS ABOUT THE PROGRAM.

IN A LETTER TO THOMAS H. MERCER, REGION NINE DIRECTOR OF THE OEO, HIGH COMMISSIONER JOHNSTON SAID THAT HE "COULD NOT APPROVE THIS GRANT EVEN AFTER VERY THOROUGH CONSIDERATION OF ALL FACTORS INVOLVED.

"WE FEEL," HE CONTINUED, "THAT THE PROGRAM HAS BEEN OVEREXPANDED, POORLY DIRECTED, WASTEFUL AND, IN MOST CASES, UNPRODUCTIVE."

THE HICOM ADDED, HOWEVER, THAT "ON BEHALF OF THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA, I DID NOT FEEL THAT I COULD DISAPPROVE THIS PROGRAM." HE SAID HE WAS ALLOWING IT TO CONTINUE FOR A THIRD

YEAR "IN HOPES THAT THE EXCESSIVE DEFICIENCIES AND
MISMANAGEMENT CAN BE ELIMINATED AND THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE
PROGRAM IMPROVED." HE ALSO EXPRESSED THE JOPE THAT IN
FUTURE YEARS THE LEVEL OF FUNDING CAN BE GREATLY REDUCED FROM
THE CURRENT 600,000 DOLLARS.

THE LEGAL SERVICES FUNDING GRANT HAS BECOME THE SUBJECT
OF SOME CONTROVERSY RECENTLY IN MICRONESIA, AND THE PROGRAM
ITSELF HAS BEEN THE TARGET OF CONSIDERABLE CRITICISM. AS
PRESENTLY STRUCTURED, THE MICRONESIAN LEGAL SERVICES
CORPORATION HAS A TERRITORIAL HEADQUARTERS ON SAIPAN, AND SIX
DISTRICT OFFICES, AND PROVIDES LEGAL SERVICES TO MICRONESIANS
IN CIVIL MATTERS, WITH CRIMINAL CASES LEFT TO THE OFFICE OF
THE PUBLIC DEFENDER. PROJECTED STAFFING CALLS FOR THREE U.S.
ATTORNEYS TO MAN EACH OF THE SIX DISTRICT OFFICES. THE
DIRECTOR OF THE PROGRAM IS TED MITCHELL.

IN HIS LETTER TO MERCER, THE HICOM INDICATED THAT ONE
OF THE FACTORS TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION IN REACHING HIS
DECISION ON THE GRANT WAUSA LZTTER FROM ONE OF THE PROGRAM'S
OWN U.S. ATTORNEYS. THAT ATTORNEY HAD URGED THE HICOM TO
VETO THE GRANT.

"I AM WRITING THIS AFTER CONSIDERABLE REFLECTION AND, ALTHOUGH I KNOW THAT OTHER MOTIVES WILL BE SUSPECTED, SOLELY BECAUSE I AM VERY MUCH DISTURBED AT A COLOSSAL WASTE OF U.S. TAXPAYER'S MONEY." THE ATTORNEY MENTIONED "LUDICROUSLY EXCESSIVE STAFF, EXCESSIVE SALARIES, UNNECESSARY STAFF MEETINGS AND TRAVEL, AND UNNEEDED EQUIPMENT" AMONG HIS EXAMPLES OF WASTE IN THE MLSC PROGRAM. HE CONCLUDED HIS LETTER, HOWEVER, BY SAYING THAT DESPITE

THIS WASTE HE FEELS THE PROGRAM IS WORTHWHILE, AND THAT "A FEW" CLIENTS WITH SERIOUS PROBLEMS WHO OTHERWISE WOULD HAVE HAD NO WAY OF OBTAINING JUSTICE HAVE BEEN HELPED BY MLSC.

THE HIGH COMMISSIONER SAID HIS VIEWS ON THE PROGRAM ARE SIMILAR TO THOSE EXPRESSED BY THE MLSC ATTORNEY. HE CONCLUDED HIS LETTER BY EXPRESSING THE HOPE THAT "A MORE REALISTIC VIEWPOINT WILL BE TAKEN REGARDING THIS PROGRAM SO THE EFFECTIVENESS AND MANAGEMENT OF THE PROGRAM MAY BE IMPROVED AND THE FUNDING KEPT MORE IN LINE WITH OUR CURRENT AND PROSPECTIVE FUTURE NEEDS."

BOYD MCKENZIE, PONAPE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR FOR A THREE YEAR TERM; FELIX RABAULIMAN, FORMER MEMBER OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA WHO A TWO YEAR TERM; CAMILLO NOKET, MANAGER OF THE TRUK FISHING COOPERATIVE, FOR A TWO YEAR TERM; AND EMILIA KOHAMA, A TEACHER AT PALAU HIGH SCHOOL AND A MEMBER OF THE OLD TT PERSONNEL BOARD FOR A TERM OF ONE YEAR.

THE NEW PERSONNEL BOARD WAS ESTABLISHED UNDER TERMS OF PUBLIC LAW 4C-49, THE NEW PUBLIC SERVICE LAW. THE ROLE OF THE BOARD HAS BEEN EXPANDED OVER THAT OF THE OLD BOARD. (TAIWAN VISITORS)
