INFORMATION ON PONAPE DISTAD BOYD MACKENZIE IS CURRENT AS OF 12 NOON SAIPAN TIME, TUESDAY, AUGUST 29.) (MACKENZIE CONDITION)

SAIPAN, AUG, 29 (MNS) --- OFFICIALS AT THE U.S. NAVY HOSPITAL ON GUAM REPORT THAT THE CONDITION OF PONAPE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR J. BOYD MACKENZIE REMAINS STABLE, BUT THAT MACKENZIE IS STILL IN THE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT AT

PAGE THREE RUHGSAA5023 UNCLAS THE HOSPITAL.

THE PONAPE DISTAD, WHO HAD HAD A HISTORY OF HEART TROUBLE, WAS STRICKEN AT HIS HOME IN PONAPE ON MONDAY (AUG. 28) AND IMMEDIATELY EVACUATED TO GUAM FOR NECESSARY TREATMENT. MACKENZIE COLLAPSED DURING THE LUNCH HOUR, SHORTLY BEFORE THE MONDAY AIR MICRONESIA FLIGHT WAS TO ARRIVE IN PONAPE. AS THE PLANE LANDED IT WAS DECIDED TO EVACUATE MACKENZIE TO GUAM.

THE PRELIMINARY REPORTS ON THE DISTAD'S CONDITION INDICATE THAT MACKENZIE EXPERIENCED A FAILURE OF A "PACEMAKER" WHICH HAD BEEN IMPLANTED IN HIS CHEST DURING HIS LAST VISIT TO THE STANFORD MEDICAL CENTER IN CALIFORNIA. THE PACEMAKER, AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE, AUTOMATICALLY STIMULATES THE HEART TO KEEP IT BEATING AT A NORMAL RATE AND AT NORMAL STRENGTH, AND IS A DEVICE IN COMMON USE BY PERSONS WHO HAVE HEART TROUBLE.

NEARLY A YEAR AGO, MACKENZIE UNDERWENT OPEN HEART SURGERY TO REPLACE A HEART VALVE. HE HAD SUFFERED TWO PREVIOUS HEART ATTACKS, BUT HAD ONLY RECENTLY BEEN GIVEN A CLEAN BILL OF HEALTH FOLLOWING AN EXAMINATION IN CALIFORNIA.

THE PAST TWO YEARS. DURING THESE TWO YEARS, 229 STUDENTS HAVE COMPLETED THEIR TRAINING AT MOC AND RETURNED HOME TO WORK OR HAVE GONE ON TO MORE TRAINING IN SCHOOLS OUTSIDE OF TRUST TERRITORY. MOC NOW HAS GRADUATES IN TRAINING IN HAWAII, THE U.S. MAINLAND, AND GUAM. A LARGE NUMBER HAVE RETURNED TO THEIR OWN DISTRICTS AND HAVE BEEN PLACED IN JOBS IN THE TRADE FOR WHICH THEY TRAINED.

REPRESENTING THE TRUST TERRITORY WAS PETER TO WILSON, CHIEF OF MARINE RESOURCES, WHO WAS ELECTED CHAIRMAN FOR THE FOUR-DAY CONFERENCE.

THE OYSTER-CULTURE EXPERT WIL BE HIRED TO DIRECT A PILOT PROGRAM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF COMMERCIAL FARMING OF OYSTERS AT THE PALAU MARICULTURE DEMONSTRATION CENTER, AND WILL BE ON A LEAVE-OF-ABSENCE FROM HIS NORMAL DUTIES AS DIRECTOR-MANAGER OF AN OYSTER RESWEARCH LABORATORY IN WASHINGTON STATE.
