(PARKS BOOK)
SAIPAN, AGU. 39 (MNS)---A REPORT ON HISTORIC SITES AND PARKS IN MICRONESIA, PREPARED BY THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE WITH THE HELP OF TT DISTRICT OFFICES, HAS GONE TO THE PRINTERS, THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT HAS ANNOUNCED.

THE HEAVILY ILLUSTRATED REPORT, CONTAINING 100 PHOTOS, IS CONSIDERED "DIFFERENT" FROM OTHER PARKS PUBLICATIONS IN

THAT IT "PROPOSES A NEW CONCEPT IN PARK MANAGEMENT," THE
DEPARTMENT SAID.

IT WAS PREPARED JOINTLY BY RUSSEL A. APPLE, OF THE U.S. NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, IN COOPERATION WITH THE BRANCH OF LAND RESOURCES, DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, AND DISTRICT OFFICES.

THE "NEW CONCEPT" INCLUDED IN THE PUBLICATION IS THAT OF ESTABLISHING "TRUST PARKS," WHEREIN A RUIN OR HISTORIC SITE IN ONE COUNTRY MAY BE OF SPECIAL SIGNIFICANCE TO ONE OR MORE OTHER COUNTRIES. THIS WOULD BE ESPECIALLY TRUE IN THE CASE OF WAR MEMORIALS.

THE REPORT EMPHASIZES THIS CONCEPT AND POINTS OUT THAT SOME HISTORIC PROPERTIES IN MICRONESIA ARE IMPORTANT ONLY TO FOREIGNERS, AND SOME HAVE SIGNIFICANCE TO FOREIGNERS WHICH OVERSHADOW THEIR IMPORTANCE TO MICRONESIA. ONE VIEW IS THAT SUCH SITES ARE HELD IN TRUST BY MICRONESIANS FOR OTHER PEOPLES.

"IF SUCH A VIEW IS ADOPTED BY THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA,"
THE REPORT STATES, "THIS ESTABLISHES A NEW CATEGORY OF HISTORICAL
PARKS--TRUST PARKS HELD BY ONE NATION FOR THE BENEFIT OF OTHER
NATIONS."

ACCORDING TO LT. CDR. ALAN PENDLETON, MILITARY LIAISON DFFICER FOR THE TRUST TERRITORY, THE VISITORS WILL INCLUDE NEARLY FIVE DOZEN ENLISTED MEN AND OFFICERS FROM COASTAL SQUADRON THREE, BASED ON GUAM. THE SQUADRON IN UNDER THE COMMAND OF COMMANDER CHARLES A DODD. ITS PATROL BOATS CONDUCT PERIODIC ISLAND SURVEILLANCE CRUISE THROUGH TRUST TERRITORY WATER.

THE SHIPS ON THIS VISIT ARE THE U·S·S· CANON AND THE U·S·S· TACOMA· IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT SOME TIME DURING THE WEEKEND THE BOATS WILL BE OPENED TO PUBLIC INSPECTION, THOUGH DEFINITE PLANS FOR THE PROPOSED OPEN HOUSE HAVE YET TO BE ANNOUNCED.

(HEALTH SERVICES MEETING)

ROTA, AUG. 30, (MNS)---THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES HAS BEEN HOLDING IMPORTANT MEETINGS ON THE ISLAND OF ROTA IN THE MARIANAS THIS WEEK. THE WORKING SESSIONS HAVE BEEN DESIGNED TO DEVELOP MANUALS AND OTHER PRACTICAL INFORMATION ON DRUGS, MEDICINES AND EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY OUTER ISLAND HEALTH ASSISTANTS IN THEIR WORK AT TT DISPENSARIES.

THE ROTA MEETINGS HAVE INVOLVED PEOPLE FROM ALL SIX DISTRICTS. THE SESSIONS CONSTITUTE A FOLLOWUP TO INITIAL MEETINGS HELD IN HONOLULU IN APRIL, WHEN THE HEALTH ASSISTANT PROGRAM WAS DEVELOPED. FOLLOWING THIS MONTH'S PHASE TWO WORKSHOPS, THERE WILL BE A THIRD ROUND OF MEETINGS IN NOVEMBER IN TRUK DISTRICT. THESE NOVEMBER MEETINGS WILL INVOLVE MAINLY THE HEALTH ASSISTANTS FROM THE TRUK-LAGOON ISLANDS.

THE PROGRAM IS FUNDED THROUGH THE REGIONAL MEDICAL PROGRAM OF HAWAII AND FOUR CONSULTANTS TO THE WORKSHOPS CAME TO THE MARIANAS FROM HAWAII AND WASHINGTON D.C. TO
