Dear Ambassador Williams:

It is my privilege, on behalf of the members of the Marianas Political Status Commission, to advise you that the Commission was duly organized on September 7, 1972. President Vicente N. Santos of the Mariana Islands District Legislature and I were selected Vice-Chairman and Chairman, respectively.

An official list of the membership of the Commission is attached for your information and reference.

The Commission has selected an interim committee consisting of Congressman Herman Q. Guerrero, President Ben Santos and I to meet with you on an informal basis to discuss matters of mutual interest relating to the Marianas issue in general as well as matters relating to our first formal negotiation. It is my hope to hold our informal meeting at your earliest convenience and, hopefully, sometime after the conclusion of the next round of Micronesian Status Negotiation in Hawaii. I would appreciate it if you would give me your thoughts on this matter.

On a separate matter, I have been advised that the next status negotiation will be held at Barber's Point in Oahu. Mrs. Guerrero and Mrs. Pangelinan are hoping to accompany Congressman Guerrero and I to the status negotiation. I would like to inquire from you whether there are lodging accommodations available for wives at Barber's Point.
