



PROPOSED SECTION  
HHA 20 Sep 72

Upon the entry into force of this Compact, all duties, rights and obligations set forth in the Trusteeship Agreement, approved by the United States and the Security Council of the United Nations, dated July 18, 1947, will be of no further effect. The authority and responsibility of the United States and the rights, duties and obligations of the United States and Micronesia shall be those set forth in this Compact, which shall be binding upon them and deemed or made part of all agreements referred to in this Compact or its Annexes.
