


This agreement made as of the gih day of July; 194h, by and between the Govemment of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, Sainan District, hereinafter called "Crantor", and the United States of Americz, hereinafter called "Grentee":

WITNESSETH:
Whereas, Grantor is the oaner of a certain parcel of land mors particularly identified as Area 15 (Domb Dump and Administraition Areas), and situated on the island of Saipan, Mariana Islands, described as follows:

Whereas, Grantor is agreeable to conveyinf the use and occupancy of the land described aforesaid for an indefinite period of time, subject to certain conditions; and

Whereas, the grantee desires to acquire the use and occupancy of the land described aforesaid for an indefinite period of time.

NOT, THE:EFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements hereinafter set forth and the mutual benefits to be derived therefrom, it is agreed as follows:

1. Estate Granted. Grantor for and in consideration of the sum of $\$ 89,760.00$, bereby grants and comeys to the grantee, the right to use and occupy the land described aforesaid for an indefinite period of time, to continue so long as the grantee has a use for said land.
2. Conditions of Grent. (A) Use To Be Consistent With Tmisteeship Agreement. The use to which the land is put by the grantee shail be consistent with the provisions and purposes of the Trusteeship Agreement relating to the Administration of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands.
(B) Review of ieed for Land Sery Five Years. In or about June 30, 1761 and on a similar date each five year period thergafter, the azency of grantee having the use and occupancy of said land or the Department of the liavy as the representative there of, and the grantor, shall jointly roview and detemine the need for continuine the use and occupancy granted hereby.
(C) Gevield by the President. In the event the review proviced for in paragraph (!) does not result in arrement as to the reed for continuing grantee's use and occupancy, the matter shall be presented to the rresident of the United States for final decision.
(D) Iemination of 1 se and Jecerancy, In the event of a decis; nn pursuant to paragraphs (i) or ( $C$ ) that a ated for the contirued $1 s e$ anc occupancy of said land dons not exist, the estate gra:sed herel, shall teminate thirty days from the date of such derision, and revert to the grantor. During said trifty day period the eramee may if it elrcts remove ary structure or improvements it has heretofore crected or may hereaje.er erfoct on the land and if thic structures or improvements cannot be removed during said thirty day period, the grantee shall be permited such additional reasonable time as may be requirad.
3. I'se of Land By Grantor, Nien not actively used by the grantee, said lands and impovoements will be made availabie to the grantor on a license tasis, for the we and terefit of the reople of the Trust rerritory. The license shall be subject to the followine coniEtions:
(A) Tre license may be revoiced at any time by the erantee so aivising the erantor in writine.
(B) The frantor shall reimburse the grantee or any utilities and services furnished.
(C) Grantor shall maintain and be responsibile for any loss or danase to the real property and personal property owned by the grantee, axcept for loss or damage caused by ordinary wear and tear, and conditions bejond the control of the erantor.
(D) Grantor shall be resporsible for any danage or injury to others arising from the use $b$ the grantar or the people of the Trust Eerritory of said land or any improvements of facilities located thercon.
(E) :1o permanent native dwellifis or setilenents shall be estaiblished on said land without the grantor obtaining orior written approval froat the grantee.

is hereby granted a license for a tem of five (5) years

occupy for agriculcural and grazing purposes
that certain percel of land containing 2,24,4 acres more or less, more parcicularly icentified as Area 15 (Bomb Dump and Administration Areas), and situated on the Island of Saipan, Mariana Islancis, and more particularly described in Use and occupancy Agrement for Land in the Trist Perritory of the Pacific Islands, Saipan District, made as of the gth day of July 1944 between the licensee herein as Grantor, and the United Stares of America as Grantee, and filed with the Clerk of Courts, Saipan District, 22 August 1956.

THIS LICBNSE is granted subject to the following provisions and conditions:

1. That the use and occupation of the said parcel of land shall be without cost or expense to the Department of the•ir Force, under the general supervision and subject to the approval of the officer having imediate jurisdiction over the sfid parcel, and subject also to such rules and regulations as he may from time to time prescribe.
2. That the licensee shall, at its own expense and Without cost or expense to the Departnent of the Air Force, maintain and keep in good repair and condition the parcel of land herein authorized to be used.

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3. That any interference with or damage to property under control of the Department of the Air Force incident to the exercise of the privileges herein granted shall be pronetly corrected by the licensee to the satisfaction of the said officer.
4. Tnat the licensee shall pay the cost, as detemined by the said ozsicex, of producing and/or supplying any utilities and other services fumished by the Deparment of the Air Force or through Deparment of the Air Force facilinies for the use of the licensee.
5. That if for any reason it should be ceemed necessary or expedient for the Department of the Air Force to perform functions and/or mender services which are the responsibility of the licensee, the saic officer may, in lieu of reimbursement, racuire the licensee to fumnish the personnel and/or materials reguired for the perfomance of said functions and/or for the rencering of said services. In addition to furnishing personncl and/or materials, the licensee shall reiniurse the Department of the Air Force for any costs incurced by the Department of the Air Force in connection With said functions and/or services, such as for supervision and/or equipment furnished. Selection of such personnel will. be subject to the approval of the said officer.
6. Mhat, on or before the date of expiration of this license or its relinquishment by the licensee, the licensae shall vacate the said parcel of land, remove its property

therefrom, and restore the said parcel to a condition satisfactory to the said officer, ordinary wear and tear and damage beyond the control of the licensee excepted. If, however, this license is revoked, the licensee shall vacate the said parcel, remove its property therefrom, and restore the said parcel as aforesaid within such time as the Secretary of the Air Force may designate.
7. That tine licensee, prior to its use and occupation hereunder of the said parcel of land, shall clear the said parcel of any anc all unexploded ammunition.
8. The licensee may sublet hereuncer, subject to the terns of this license and, the tems, conditions and provisions of the Use and Occupancy Agreement above described, Which are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this license.
9. This pernit is revocable at will by the Secretary of the Air Force upon written notice, commensurate with the terms of the said Use and Occupancy Agreement.

WHEFEAS, on the and day of December 1966, the UNITED. STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Commander, Pacific Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, herein called the "Licensor" granted THE GOVERNMENT OF THE TRUST PERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS, SAIPAN DISTRICT, herein called the "Licensee", a license for a term of five (5) years beginning 1 July 1966 and ending 30 June 1971 to use Air Force Retention Area 15 (Nafutan-Obiam Bomb Dump and Administration Area, Saipan Island) for agricultural and grazing purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Licensee has a continuing requirement for the license premises; and

WHEREAS, the Licensor is willing to extend the term of said license for an additional five (5) year term;

WHEREAS, on the 2 nd day of December 1966, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Commander, Pacific Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, herein called the "Licensor" granted THE GOVERNMENT. OF THE TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS, SAIPAN DISTRICT, herein called the "Licensee", a license for a tern of five (5) years beginning 1 July 1966 and ending 30 June 1971 to use Air Force Retention Area 15 (Nafutan-Obiam Bomb Dump and Administration Area, Saipan Island) for agricultural and grazing purposes; and

WHEREAS, said license was subsequently amended to extend the term to 30 June 1976;

WHEREAS, the Licensee has a requirement to emplace obstruction landing lights within the area; and

WHEREAS, the Licensor is willing to grant such use of the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, said license is hereby amended to permit the emplacement of obstruction landing lights and appurtenant equipment. Such emplacement shall be in accordance with drawings approved by the Licensor.

IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS, the terms and conditions of said license as hereby amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
