In accordance with our discussion last week, I have personally talked to all the lawyers we listed, and they shall all be expecting to hear from you and later to personally see you. I might say that they all seemed most interested.

After you left, Howard Westwood called me back to say that he would have to stick to the arrangements suggested in his letter to you. This, I think, prices them out of the competition. All the others seemed receptive to a more modest fee arrangement with a maximum of \$25,000 during the first year and with the understanding that any work above that figure, in order to efficiently represent the Mariana Islands, would be done without additional charge.

Call me when you get to town and I'll help you in setting up your appointments and in whatever other way I can.
