ON THE FUTURE POLITICAL STATUS OF THE MARIANAS
ISLANDS HAS BEEN SET FOR DECEMBER 13th.
ADMINISTERED BY THE UNITED STATES SINCE 1947,
UNDER A UNITED NATIONS TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENT,
THE WESTERN PACIFIC ISLAND GROUP HAS LONG
DESIRED A CLOSER POLITICAL TIE WITH THE U. S.
THE U. S. DEPUTY REPRESENTATIVE, JAMES WILSON,
JR., OUTLINES SOME OF THE STEPS LEADING TO
THIS NEW ROUND OF TALKS.

LAST APRIL, REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE
MARIANAS INFORMED AMBASSADOR WILLIAMS THAT THE
MARIANAS WISHED TO SEEK A FUTURE STATUS SEPARATI
FROM THE REST OF MICRONESIA WHICH WOULD INVOLVE
A FORM OF POLITICAL UNION WITH THE UNITED
STATES.

THEIR REPRESENTATIVES SAID MORE THAN ANY OTHER NATION WITH WHICH WE HAVE HAD CONTACT, THE UNITED STATES HAS BROUGHT TO OUR PEOPLE THE VALUES WHICH WE CHERISH AND THE ECONOMIC GOALS WHICH WE DESIRE.

THIS REQUEST, WAS REITEREATED BY
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MARIANAS AT THE UN
TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL MEETING IN NEW YORK IN MAY.
THE U. S. RESPONDED AFFIRMATIVELY TO THE
MARIANAS REQUEST, AND THE MARIANAS HAVE
ESTABLISHED THEIR OWN COMMISSION TO REPRESENT
THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANAS IN THE FORTHCOMING
