### JOINT COMMUNICUE

The Marianas Political Status Commission and the President's Personal Representative met in Saipan December 13-14, 1172 for the formal opening of negotiations which had been requested by the Marianas with a view to achieving union between the Mariana Islands and the United States of America.

The meetings consisted of a festive inaugural ceremony, a public plenary opening session and informal working talks. These afforded the opportunity for warm exchanges between the two delegations in anticipation of a future working relationship which will benefit all concerned.
