THE APPOINTMENTS WERE MADE DURING A LEADERSHIP MEETING
OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA
BECAUSE THREE OF THE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE COMMISSION ARE NOT

MEMBERS OF CONGRESS AND WE HAD TO WAIT TO HEAR OF THEIR ACCEPTANCE," ACCORDING TO LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL KALEB UDUI.

THE NON-CONGRESS APPOINTEES ARE: SYLVESTER ALONZ, SECRETARY OF THE PALAU DISTRICT LEGISLATURE, MISS GUADALUPE BORJA, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRUST TERRITORY PUBLIC INFORMATION DIVISION, AND JOHN EDMUND, A MEMBER OF THE PONAPE DISTRICT LEGISLATURE.

MEMBERS OF THE CONGRESS APPOINTED WERE: SENATOR TOSINO MAKAYAMA, TEMPORARY CHAIRMAN, SENATOR PETRUS TUN, AND REPRESENTATIVE CHARLES DONNICK.

THE HIGH COMMISSIONER APPOINTED DWIGHT HEINE, SPECIAL CONSULTANT, MARCELINO UNVECH, OF THE TRUST TERRITORY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, AND ISIDORO RUDINCH, A BUSINESSMAN FROM PALAU DISTRICT. THIS BRINGS TO NINE THE TOTAL NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION AS CREATED BY LAW.

THE PURPOSE OF THE COMMISSION IS TO FORMULATE POLICIES AND PROGRAMS WHICH WILL ALLOW MICRONESIANS "TO MAKE A RATIONAL, WELL CONSIDERED DECISION AS TO POLITICAL STATUS, AND (PREPARE) MICRONESIANS

TO PARTICIPATE IN THEIR FUTURE GOVERNMENT." ACCORDING TO THE PUBLIC LAW.

THE INITIAL FUNDING FOR THE COMMISSION'S WORK WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS. THE COMMISSION IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE CONGRESS ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 15, 1975.
