AT THE INVITATION OF SENATOR EDWARD DLG PANGELINAN AND PRESIDENT VICENTE N. SANTOS, CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN RESPECTIVELY OF THE MAR-

IANAS PILITICAL STATUS COMMISSION, AMBASSADOR HAYDN WILLIAMS, THE PRESIDENT'S PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE FOR MICRONESIAN STATUS NEGOTIATIONS, MET FRIDAY AFTERNOON, AUGUST 31 ON SAIPAN WITH THE MPSC AND THE

MARIANAS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE TO DISCUSS STEPS NOW UNDERWAY IN THE ON-

GOING NEGOTIATIONS TOWARD THE FUTURE PILITICAL STATUS OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT.

PRESENT ALSO WERE THE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE SAIPAN MUNICIPAL

COUNCIAL, AS WELL AS CAPTAIN RICHARD SCOTT, USN, WHO HAS RECENTLY AS=
SUMED THE POSIT OF DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE FOR MICRONESIAN STATS
NEGOTIATIONS, AND MISS MARY VANCE TRENT, LIAISON OFFICER FOR
MICRONESIAN STATUS NEGOTIATIONS.

THE DISCUSSION ON SAIPAN FOLLOWED AN EARLIER MEETING ON GUAM ON AUGUST 29 AT WHICH THE AMBASSADOR, SENATOR PANGELINAN AND PRESIDENT SANTOS REVIEWED THE CURRENT ACTIVITIES AND PROGRESS OF THE SUB-COMM-ITTEES NOW AT WORK ON EACH SIDE, IN LINE WITH AGREEMENT REACHED IN THE

STATUS TALKS OF LAST MAY-JUNE, IN SUCH FIELDS AS LEGAL ASPECTS OF THE ENVISAGED STATUS ARRANGEMENT, ECONOMICS

AND FINANCE, AND LAND. THEY AGREED THAT APPROXIMATELY TWO MONTHS HOULE

BE REQUIRED TO EXAMINE THE RESULTS OF THE STUDIES. THEY THEREFORE AGREED TENTATIVELY THAT THE NEXT MEETING IN THE MARIANAS STATUS NEGOTIA-

TIONS SERIES SHOULD TAKE PLACE SHORTLY AFTER MID-NOVEMBER.

AT THE MEETING ON SAIPAF THE AMBASSADOR REVIEWED THE CONSIDERABLE
PROGRESS IN THE MARIANAS STATUS NEGOTIATIONS OVER THE PAST MONTHS AND
TOOK OCCASION TO STRESS THAT THE STATUS AGREEMENT WHEN REACHED WILL BE

REFERRED FOR APPROVACE TO THE MARIANAS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE AND BY PLE-BISCITE TO THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANAS.

THE SUBJECT OF PRINCIPAL CONCERN AT THE MEETING WAS THE QUESTION OF

PAGE FOUR RUNGSAA3585 UNCLAS
PERMITS FOR HOMESTEADING AND FOREIGN BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS ON TINIAN

IN THIS INTERIM PERIOD PENDING TVE COMPLETION OF STATUS NEGOTIATIONS. ACKNOWLEDGING WITH REGRET THAT THERE HAD NOT BEEN SUFF-ICIENT COMMUNICATION AND COORDIATION WITH THE MPSC CONCERNING THE TEM-

PORARY SUSPENSION OF SUCH PERMITS, THE AMBASSADOR STATED THAT MEASURES

WOULD BE TAKEN TO PVEVENT SUCH A GAP IN THE FUTURE. HE STRESSED THE REASONS FOR THE SUSPENSION OF PERMITS IN ORDER TO PREVENT LAND SPECULATION AND PREEMPTION OF BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES, NEITHER OF WHICH WOULD BE IN THE INTEREST OF THE PEOPLE OF TINIAN NOR OF THE UNITED STA

TES POINTING OUT THAT THE SUSPENSION OF LAND ACQUISITION IN AREAS UNDER CONSIDERATION FOR PUBLIC USE IS OUTA NORMAL PROCEDURE, THE AMBASS SADOR

STRESSED THAT SUCH SUSPENSION IS CUSTOMARILY TEMPORARY UNTIL FINAL DECISIONS ARE MADE AND STATED THAT IN THE CASE OF LAND ON TINIAN SUCH SUSPENSION SIL FIHOULD BE THOUGHT OF IN TERMS OF WEEKS RATHERTHAN YEAR AS HAS BEEN MISTAKENLY ASSUMED IN SOME CASES.

CONCERN WAS ALSO EXPRESSED IN THE MEETING WITH REGARD TOTHE GRANTIN

OF LONG-TERM LEASES OF LAND IN THE MARIANAS TO NON-MICRONESIANS AND TH

AMBASSADOR AND SENATOR PANGELINAN EXPRESSED AGREEMENT THAT THIS SUB-JECT SHOULD BE AMONG THOSE ON WHICH JOINT CONSIDERATION IS ADVISABLE. THE AMBASSADOR EXPRESSED HIS APPRECIATION FOR THE OPPORTUNITY TO
