IN ALL NINE MICRONESIAN LANGUAGES PLUS ENGLISH (SB 41); APPROPRIATE \$30,000 FOR THE PALAU MUSEUM (SB44); CREATE A MICRONESIAN BROADCASTING COMMISSION (SB 45); ESTABLISH A JOINT ECONOMIC PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (SB 46); AND IMPOSE A REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX (SB 47).

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS ALSO HIGHLIGHTED THE HOUSE SESSION MONDAY, WITH TWELVE NEW MEASURES OFFERED. THEY WOULD: PROHIBIT CAMPAIGNING FOR PUBLIC OFFICE OR CONDUCTING OF ANY PARTISAN POLITICAL ACTIVITY IN ANY TT GOVERNMENT BUILDING (HB 14); AMEND THE TT CODE RELATING TO PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION OF ELECTION LAWS (HB 15); AMEND THE CODE RELATING TO JURISDICTION OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS (HB 16); AUTHORIZE MUNICIPALITIES TO LEVY AND COLLECT TAXES UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES (HB 17); PROVIDE FOR IMMUNIFICATION AGAINST CONTAGIOUS DISEASES FOR TT SCHOOL PUPILS (HB 18); GRANT JURISDICTION TO THE HIGH COURT TO HEAR CASES AGAINST THE ALIEN PROPERTY CUSTODIAN (HB 19); PROVIDE FOR THE PERIODIC RE-CONFIRMATION OF DISTRICT ADMINISTRATORS BY THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA (HB 20); REQUIRE THE DIRECTOR OF EACH GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE HIGH COMMISSIONER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT TO THE CONGRESS A PROPOSAL FOR THE FILING OF EACH "POLICY-MAKING" TT GOVERNMENT POSITION WITH A MICRONESIAN (HB 21); ESTABLISH A DISASTER CONTROL OFFICE AND PROGRAM, AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR IT (HB 22); PROVIDE FOR THE TAKING OF A TERRITORY-WIDE CENSUS IN 1973 (HB 23); APPROPRIATE \$52,000 FOR THE EXPENSES OF

THE TT PERSONNEL BOARD (HB 24); AND APPROPRIATE \$257,000 DOLLARS TO DEFRAY EXPENSES OF THE TAX OFFICES (HB 25). THE LAST FOUR BILLS, INTRODUCED AT THE REQUEST OF THE ADMINISTRATION, ARE THE SAME AS BILLS ALREADY OFFERED IN THE SENATE.

OF YAP, WHO DIED IN AN AUTOMOBILE ACCIDENT ON GUAM LAST MONTH, WAS A MAN WHO "DESPITE WEIGHTY AND SERIOUS DELIBERATIONS, COULD RISE ABOVE THE SITUATION AND PROVIDE HIS COLLEAGUES AND CO-WORKERS WITH A MOMENT OF MIRTH TO EASE THE STRAIN OF DAILY WORK."

WITH THESE WORDS, PALAU'S SENATOR ROMAN TMETUHL SPEECH LAST WEEK ON SAIPAN, "FRANCIS NUJAN," HE SAID, "WAS A MAN WHO COULD SEE MICRONESIA AS PART OF THE LARGER WORLD, WHO HAD THE SENSE OF MAN'S FOLLY, BUT NEVER DESPAIRED OF IT, AND WHO COULD VIEW HIMSELF AND OTHERS WITH A SLIGHTLY IRONIC WIT WHICH ENDEARED HIM TO HIS COLLEAGUES AND FELLOW MEN."

SENATOR TMETUHL THEN CALLED ATTENTION TO A SENATE RESOLUTION AUTHORED BY SENATOR NUJAN IN 1966, ASKING THAT IT

BE READ INTO THE RECORD AS A REMEMBRANCE OF THE MAN AND OF HIS SENSE OF HUMOR. IT WAS A PIECE OF LEGISLATION, HE SAID, WHICH SHOWED "HIS CONCERN WITH THE EXPENSE OF OPERATING THE CONGRESS, AND THE HABIT OF EARLY CONGRESSES OF PASSING RESOLUTIONS--WHICH ONE FORMER MEMBER OF THIS HOUSE COMPARED FAVORABLY WITH 'PRAYERS'--INSTEAD OF LAWS..." AND IT "DESERVES NOT TO BE LOST" DESPITE ITS OWN RESOLVING CLAUSE THAT IT NOT BE PRINTED.

WHEREUPON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE WAS READ INTO THE SENATE JOURNAL:

"WHEREAS, THE WEIGHTIER RESPONSIBILITY AND HEAVY WORKLOAD OF THIS SENATE OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA, SECOND REGULAR SESSION, 1966, HAVE NOT DISCOURAGED THE HONORABLE SENATORS FROM INTRODUCING AND ACTING UPON A NUMBER OF RESOLUTIONS CONGRATULATORY IN NATURE; AND

"WHEREAS, THE PROCESS OF HANDLING SAID RESOLUTIONS CONSUMES A GREAT DEAL OF TIME; AND NO SMALL AMOUNT OF MONEY; NOW, THEREFORE,

"BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA, SECOND REGULAR SESSION, 1966, THAT WE HEREBY

"(1) ALL INHABITANTS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY, INCLUDING THE CITIZENS THEREOF, AND ALL FOREIGN NATIONAL, INCLUDING AMERICAN CITIZENS, RESIDING WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE TRUST TERRITORY, ON THE OCCASION OF THE ANNIVERSARIES OF THE DATES OF THEIR RESPECTIVE BIRTHS;

"(2) ALL CHAMPIONSHIP ATHLETIC TEAMS FOR THEIR PROWESS AND TALENT;

"(3) ALL SCHOLARS FOR THEIR INTELLECTUAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS;

"(4) ALL TRAVELERS TO AND FROM THE 'PARADISE IN TRUST' ON THEIR ABILITY TO TRAVEL NOW AND PAY LATER, OR TO FIND SOMEONE WITHIN OR WITHOUT MICRONESIA TO PAY FOR THEM;

"(5) ALL BUSINESSES, WHETHER MICRONESIA OWNED AND CONTROLLED OR OTHERWISE, WHO HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THEIR EMPLOYEES, STOCKHOLDERS, AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS;

"(6) ALL NEWS MEDIA WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE TRUST TERRITORY FOR THEIR PUBLIC SERVICE, VALUABLE OR OTHERWISE;

"(7) ALL MOTHERS WHO HAVE OR WILL CONTRIBUTE THIS YEAR OR
