BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the sense of the Congress that

the Congress of Micronesia, through the Joint Committee on Future Status,

is the sole authority in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands which

19 is legally authorized and empowered to conduct negotiations with regard

20 to the future political status of the Trust Territory, including all parts

21 thereof, and that the Congress has the sole responsibility to negotiate

on behalf of and provide for the future political status of the entire
