A SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the Government of Japan to amend the present requirement that Trust Territory citizens must obtain a visa for each entry into Japan, and to grant Trust Territory citizens multiple entry visas on the same terms and conditions afforded to citizens of the United States of America.

- WHEREAS, citizens of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands may
 be granted only a single-entry visa, which is good for only six months,

 for entry into Japan, for which a fee is charged; and

 WHEREAS, citizens of the United States may be issued multiple-entry
 visas, good for four years, without fee, for such purposes; and

 WHEREAS, under the terms of the Trusteeship Agreement between the
 United States and the United Nations, the United States, as Administering
- 8 Authority for the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, is obligated to
- 9 provide diplomatic and consular protection for the people of the Trust
- 10 Territory; and
- 11 WHEREAS, since the people of the Trust Territory are under such
- 12 protection, it is the sense of the Congress of Micronesia that such pri-
- 13 vileges as are accorded to United States citizens with regard to entry into
- $1^{l_{\parallel}}$ Japan ought also to be accorded to citizens of the Trust Territory; and
- WHEREAS, the people of the Trust Territory have strong historical ties
- 16 with Japan, and are developing a growing business relationship with Japanese
- 17 firms, and are frequent tourists to Japan, with the result that more and
- 18 more citizens have occasion to visit Japan each year; now, therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate, of the Fifth Congress of Micronesia, First
- 20 Regular Session, 1973, the House of Representatives concurring, that the
- 21 Government of Japan is hereby respectfully requested to amend the present
- 22 requirements concerning visas for entry into Japan by citizens of the Trust
- 23 Territory, and to allow such citizens a four-year multiple-entry, no-fee
- 24 visa, being the same privilege accorded to citizens of the United States of
- 25 America; and
