I appreciate it very much for keeping me fully informed of your activities on the Marianas Status. The various memoranda have been most informative.

The U. N. Visiting Mission is arriving this afternoon on Saipan for the purposes of meeting with the Congress of Micronesia and the Joint Committee on Future Status. I will be in a much better position to respond to your various inquiries in your letter of February 5 after I have had the opportunity of meeting with the Visiting Mission.

Enclosed is a check in the amount of \$3,000 per your billing of February 5. I have no objection to have the Commission billed on a monthly basis at \$3,000 or larger sum. The Commission is flexible on this matter.

The First Regular Session of the Congress of Micronesia will be adjourned sine die within a few days and I will be communicating with you at some length.
