- 24 (2) Subject to approval by resolution of the district
- 25 legislature of the district affected, foreign fishing

1 vessels shall be granted permission to enter the
2 following ports for the purpose of purchasing supplies
3 and provisions including food, fuel and water and for
4 the purpose of granting shore leave to crew members:

- 5 (a) Mariana Islands District - Tanapag Harbor,
6 Saipan;
7 (b) Palau District - Malakal Harbor, Koror;
8 (c) Yap District - Tomil Harbor, Yap;
9 (d) Truk District - Moen Anchorage, Moen;
10 (e) Ponape District - Ponape Harbor, Ponape;
11 (f) Marshall Islands District - Darrit
12 Anchorage, Majuro and Jabor Anchorage,
13 Jaluit.

14 (3) Native varieties of live bait fish may only be
15 sold to foreign fishing vessels if such sales are authorized
16 by law of the district affected. The High Commissioner
17 shall prescribe rules and regulations to control the
18 opening of ports to foreign fishing vessels, including
19 regulations for the conservation of native stocks of live
20 bait fish. The High Commissioner may also grant access
21 to additional ports, not designated in this subsection,
22 to foreign fishing vessels subject to approval of the
23 district legislature of the district affected.

24 (4) The district fishing authority shall be the
25 exclusive agent for the sale of all supplies and

1 provisions to foreign fishing vessels. Nothing here-
2 in shall be construed to prohibit crew members from
3 purchasing goods and services from local merchants for
4 their personal use. In the sale of provisions and
5 supplies to foreign fishing vessels, the district
6 fishing authority shall purchase such supplies and
7 provisions from local merchants wherever feasible.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval by
9 the High Commissioner, or upon its otherwise becoming law without
10 such approval.
