The U.S. Delegation has even proposed such a
review arrangement, though in the context of Free Association:

"After an agreed period of years during
which the association could be given a
practical test, either party could pro-
pose amendments or termination of the
Compact. The party to which such pro-
posals were directed would agree to
consider them promptly, to respond to
them within a specified time, and to
negotiate differences between the parties
in good faith. Procedures for such
negotiations could be agreed upon in
advance in order to expedite the resolution
of any differences that might arise."
