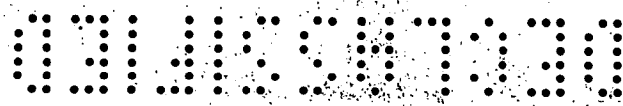

LARGE, THE SIX DISTRICT ADMINISTRATORS HAVE EACH BEEN ASKED

PAGE SIX RUHGSAA3096 UNCLAS

TO NOMINATE THREE RESIDENTS OF THEIR DISTRICT WHO WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR NOMINATION AS DISTRICT MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION. THAT SELECTION PROCESS IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED BY LATE AUGUST, WITH THE FIRST ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSION TENTATIVELY SET FOR OCTOBER 15.

IN NAMING ALLEN TO THE POST, THE HICOM SAID SEVERAL FACTORS WERE CONSIDERED. AS CHIEF OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIVISION, ALLEN HAS SPENT A NUMBER OF YEARS PIONERRING THE HOUSING PROGRAM IN THE TT. HE HAS ESTABLISHED A GOOD WORKING RELATIONSHIP WITH THE VARIOUS HOUSING AUTHORITIES, AND PARTICIPATED IN ORGANIZING THE TT DELEGATION TO A HOUSING SEMINAR HELD RECENTLY IN HAWAII UNDER THE SPONSORSHIP OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT.

HE TRAVELED UNDER THE AUSPICES OF HUD TO VARIOUS PARTS OF THE UNITED STATES TO INSPECT HOUSING AND RENEWAL PROGRAMS. ALLEN ALSO WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN FRAMING AND SUPPORTING THE COMMUNITY HOUSING ACT OF 1973.

(BORJA TO MAKE TRIP)

SAIPAN JUNE 1 (CONGRESS RELEASE)---SENATOR OLYMPIO T. BORJA OF THE MARIANAS WILL LEAVE NEXT WEEK FOR MEETINGS IN NEW YORK IN WASHINGTON, D.C. CONCERNING THE PEOPLE OF RONGELAP AND UTIRIK IN THE MARSHALL ISLANDS DISTRICT.

SENATOR BORJA, CHAIRMAN OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA'S SPECIAL JOINT COMMITTEE CONCERNING RONGELAP AND UTIRIK, EXPECTS

TO MEET WITH DR. ROBERT A. CONARD AT THE BROOKHAVEN NATIONAL LABORATORY IN LONG ISLAND, NEW YORK. IT IS EXPECTED THEY WILL DISCUSS WHAT PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE IN IMPLEMENTING SOME OF THE COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATIONS, AND ALSO MEET WITH RESIDENTS OF THE MARSHALLS WHO WILL BE UNDERGOING EXAMINATION AT BROOKHAVEN.

BORJA WILL THEN TALK WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION IN WASHINGTON, D.C. TO DISCUSS CERTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS AND PROPOSALS THE COMMITTEE HAS MADE REGARDING THE HEALTH OF THE AFFECTED MARSHALLESE, AND CERTAIN ASPECTS OF COMPENSATION FOR THEM.

FINALLY HE HOPES TO MEET WITH MEMBERS OF THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO INFORM THEM OF THE COMMITTEE'S CURRENT WORK AND TO ENLIST THEIR SUPPORT FOR ITS ACTIVITIES.

AT PRESENT THE COMMITTEE IS WORKING ON ITS SECOND REPORT TO THE CONGRESS WHICH WILL DEAL WITH POSSIBLE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR THE PEOPLE OF RONGELAP AND UTIRIK WHO HAVE YET TO BE COMPENSATED FOR THEIR 1954 EXPOSURE TO RADIOACTIVE FALLOUT FROM U.S. TESTS.

DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR IS VISITING THE TRUST TERRITORY THIS WEEKEND. HE IS ROYSTON C. HUGHES, ASSISTANT TO SECRETARY OF INTERIOR ROGERS C.B. MORTON.

HUGHES ARRIVED ON SAIPAN EARLY FRIDAY MORNING (JUNE 1) FOR AN OVERNIGHT STAY, DURING WHICH HE WAS EXPECTED TO MEET WITH TRUST TERRITORY HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON AND MEMBERS OF THE ADMINISTRATION STAFF. SATURDAY MORNING HE WILL FLY TO YAP BY WAS OF GUAM, FOR A SHORT, THREE-HOUR VISIT BETWEEN PLANES. IN YAP HE IS EXPECTED TO MEET WITH DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR LEONARD AGUIGUI AND HIS STAFF AND BE GIVEN A TOUR OF THE DISTRICT CENTER BEFORE RETURNING TO GUAM THAT SAME AFTERNOON.
