1. TC SECRETARIAT ADVISES US THAT TINIAN STUDENTS IN SAN FRANCISCO HAVE REQUESTED HEARING BEFORE CURRENT SESSION OF COUNCIL. LETTER FROM THEM OPPOSES US MILITARY PLANS FOR TINIAN. IN ADDITION, FRIENDS OF MICRONESIA REPRESENTATIVE IN NEW YORK (FORMER PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SUSAN COSTELLO), FRIENDS (QUAKERS) PEACE COMMITTEE OF PHILADELPHIA, AND, AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED, BALERIO PEDRO, HAVE ALSO ASKED TO BE HEARD AS PETITIONERS. WE UNDERSTAND QUAKERS WISH TO MAKE STATEMENT OPPOSING PACIFIC ATOLL CRATERING EXPERIMENT (PACE) PLANNED FOR ENIWETOK. TC SECY PRADAS ALSO HAS HEARD RUMOR THAT PROFESSOR FREEMAN MAY ASK TO BE HEARD.

2. TC SECRETARIAT HAS NOT YET RECEIVED LETTER FROM MARIANAS STATUS COMMISSION PETITIONERS. WE THEREFORE RECOMMEND THEY CABLE THEIR REQUEST DIRECTLY TO PRADAS.
