IN PAGE TWO ARTICLE ENTITLED "PALAUAN CLANS MAY FACE BOOT", PACIFIC DAILY NEWS REPORTER ROBERT THOMPSON OPENED HIS COVERAGE TODAY AUGUST 10 OF GUAM PRESS CONFERENCE AUGUST 9 OF PRESIDENT'S DEPUTY REPRESENTATIVE WILSON WITH STATEMENT THET SOME 6-700 KOROR FAMILIES FACE POSSIBLE DISPLACEMENT UNDER CONDITIONS ASSOCIATED WITH RETURN OF PUBLIC LANDS TO CHIEFS IN PALAU. STORY SAYS HILSON STATED THAT CHIEFS" CLAIM THE LAND AND HAVE MADE IT VERY CLEAR IN HIS TALKS WITH THEM THAT THE PEOPLE LIVING THREE WILL HAVE TO RENEGOTIATE WITH THE CHIEFS FOR THEIR HOMES.
