GOVERNMENT IS DELIBERATELY WITHHOLDING A POLITICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM FROM THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA SENATOR LAZARUS SALII OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA HAS CHANGED.

SENATOR SALII, WHO HEADS THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON FUTURE STATUS, TODAY SEVERELY CRITICIZED THE OFFICE OF MICRONESIAN STATUS NEGOTIATIONS (CMSN) WHICH HE SAYS HAS SUPPRESSED A BOOKLET AND SOME TAPES PRODUCED BY THE TRUST TERRITORY DEPARTMANT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS.

ACCORDING TO THE SENATOR, THE BOOKLET AND TAPES WERE

PAGE THREE RUHGSAA6216 UNCLAS PRODUCED BY THE EFFORT OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE'S FORMER STAFF MEMBER, WHO WENT TO WURK FOR PUBLIC AFFAIRS WITH THE EXPRESS PURPOSE OF CREATING SUCH A PROGRAM.

HOWEVER, THE SENATOR HAS RECENTLY LEARNED THAT BEFORE THE MATERIAL WAS RELEASED, IT WAS REVIEWED BY SEVERAL PEOPLE IN THE ADMINISTRATION, INCLUDING THE STATE DEPARTMENT STATUS LIAISUN OFFICER, MISS MARY TRENT. FROM HER, THEY WERE SENT TO THE OFFICE OF MICRONESIAN STATUS NEGOTIATIONS HEADED BY AMBASSADOR FRANKLIN WILLIAMS AND OMSN DIRECTOR JAMES WILSON.

TEURTHERMORE, A VERY HIGH OFFICIAL IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH HAT INFORMED ME THAT HE WAS TOLD ANY FURTHER POLITICAL EDULATION FERRITORS WILL BE DEVELOPED IN WASHINGTON, D.C. AND THE MATTER 1S NO CONGER A CONCERN OF THE TRUST TERRITORY ADMINISTRATION, "HE D.

CHAIRMAN SALII ALSO MADE REFERENCE TO A REMARK MADE BY THE SIGS COMMISSIONER AT THE UNITED NATIONS TO THE EFFECT THAT: WE HAVE IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE TRUST TERRITORY SUVERNMENT TAKEN CERTAIN VERY SPECIFIC STEPS IN THE LAST FER WEEKS AND MONTHS TO DEVELOP A PROGRAM OF POLITICAL EDUCATION," "BUT WHAT HAS HAPPENED TO THIS PROGRAM," SALII SAID, "\$S

BI BELIEVE THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA SHOULD KNOW THE FACTS. IT IS NOT THE COMGRESS OR THE JOINT COMMITTEE THAT ARE HOLDING BACK POLITICAL EDUCATION IN MICRONESIA. IT IS THE ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY, AN ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY WHICH IS CHARGED WITH A ISACRED TRUST! FOR THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA, AN ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY WHICH IS SUPPOSED TO PROMOTE==NOT SUPPRESS==POLITICAL EDUCATION ACCORDING TO THE TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENT1! HE SAID.
