TALKING POINTS

STATED REQUIREMENT FOR ALL OF TINIAN --2/3 for Military --1/3 for Lease-back

Moratorium on Homesteading

Obvious reasons for not permitting homesteading until land settled such as:

- a. Prevent undue land speculation (to U.S. detriment).
- b. Prevent land alienation .- Knowy long for m beares
- c. Unfair to Tinianese to grant homesteads when land may be in military domain.
- d. If all of Tinian used by U. S., there will be no more homesteadingonly lease back of those areas not required for military installations.

e. U. S. Congressional reaction,

(1) Cong. SIKES inquired of OSD if any safeguards were present

to prevent land speculation on Tinian, implying that without such safeguards, Congress would not go along with base development funds.
