TRAINING OF BROADCAST PERSONNEL WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN ESTABLISHING THE PHILIPPINES GOVERNMENT BROADCAST NETWORK. HE ALSO HAS TRAINED BROADCASTERS IN MANY NATIONS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD IN HIS ROLE OF INSTRUCTOR WITH UNESCO.

IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE COURSE, SAVERCOOL SAID, FATHER MEL WILL BE WORKING PRIMARILY IN THE AREA OF SCRIPT WRITING AND DRAMA, WITH AN EMPHASIS ON THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF PROGRAMS.
