SAIPAN, OCT. 1. (MNS)---ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION HAS RESIGNED. IN A LETTER TO MARIANAS DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR FRANCISCO C. ADA WHICH WAS READ AT THE MONDAY (OCT. 1) MEETING OF THE SAIPAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, SAIPAN BUSINESSMAN JOSE C. TENORIO SAID HE IS RESIGNING AS THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY ON THE COMMISSION.

TAKING NOTE OF THE RESIGNATION, THE CHAMBER THEN VOTED TO SUBMIT THE NAME OF PEDRO A. TENERIO OF SAIPAN TO THE DISTAD FOR CONSIDERATION AS A REPLACEMENT FOR JOSE C. TENORIO.

PEDRO A. TENERIO IS A HYDROLOGGIST AND FORMER TT GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE NOW IN PRIVATE BUSINESS IN THE MARIANAS. HE RAN UNSUCCESSFULLY FOR A SENATE SEAT IN THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA LAST YEAR. HE HAD EARLIER BEEN SELECTED BY THE SAIPAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AS AN ALTERNATE TO JOSE C. TENORIO, SHOULD HE BE UNABLE TO SERVE ON THE COMMISSION.

THE RESIGNATION OF JOSE C. TENORIO FROM THE STATUS NEGOTIATING TEAM IS THE SECOND IN AS MANY MONTHS. LAST MONTH HERMAN M. MANGLONA OF TINIAN SUBMITTED HIS RESIGNATION, TO BE REPLACED BY FORMER TINIAN MAYOR JOSE R. CRUZ.

IN HIS LETTER TO THE DISTAD, JOSE C. TENORIO SAID HIS PERSONAL BUSINESS COMMITMENTS, WHICH REQUIRE HIS FULL ATTENTION, ARE ONE REASON HE IS RESIGNING FROM THE COMMISSION. HE IS PRESIDENT OF J.C. TENORIO ENTERPRISES, ONE OF SAIPAN'S LARGEST COMPANIES.

"SECONDLY," HE SAID IN HIS LETTER, "I BELIEVE THAT THE COMMISSION CAN FUNCTION MORE EFFECTIVELY BY HAVING ITS MEMBERS COMPOSED OF PEOPLE WITHOUT 'REPUTATION' OF BEING IN CONFLICT WITH THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TALKS. I AM SURE YOU ARE AWARE THAT MY IDENTIFICATION WITH BUSINESS AND POLITICAL ISSUES

ARE WELL-KNOWN. THIS HAS HAD, IN MY OPINION, A NEGATIVE EFFECT ON MY PARTICIPATION AS A MEMBER. IN AS MUCH AS I HAVE TRIED TO BE ABSOLUTELY GENUINE AND IMPARTIAL ON ISSUES BEFORE THE MEMBERS DURING THE TALKS, I FOUND THAT NO MATTER WHAT I SAY, THERE IS ALWAYS A FEELING AMONG THE COMMISSION MEMBERS THAT I WAS BAISED, OR THAT WHAT I HAD SAID WAS FOR MY PERSONAL PROTECTION OF MY BUSINESS AND POLITICAL INTEREST. I FOUND THAT MY PARTICIPATION AS A BUSINESSMAN'S REPRESENTATIVE

ON THE COMMISSION IS DIFFICULT TO RECONCILE WITH THE MEMBERS

SAIPAN, OCT. 1, (MNS)---THE DISTRICT CENTER OF THE
MARSHALL ISLANDS, MAJURO, HAS JOINED THE OTHER FIVE DISTRICTS
OF THE TRUST TERRITORY WITH A DIAL TELEPHONE SERVICE INAUGURATED

LAST WEEK ON WEDNESDAY, (SEPT. 28). ACCORDING TO TELEPHONE
SPECIALIST LARRY CROSSLEY, MORE THAN 40 OF THE PROJECTED 100
TELEPHONE LINES ARE NOW FUNCTIONING.

THE FIRST 40 TELEPHONE LINES WERE HOOKED TO GOVERNMENT
OFFICES WITH BUSINESS AND PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS TO BE HOOKED LATER.
WITH THE INSTALLATION OF A TELEPHONE SYSTEM IN MAJURO, ALL SIX
DISTRICTS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY NOW HAVE TELEPHONE SERVICE.
SAIPAN STILL LEADS IN THE NUMBER OF PHONES INSTALLED WITH 1900.
PONAPE IS SECOND WITH 300, FOLLOWED BY PALAU WITH 188; TRUK, 159;
YAP WITH 78 AND MAJURO SHORTLY WILL HAVE 100.

TWO EMPLOYEES OF THE MARSHALLS DISTRICT PUBLIC WORKS
DEPARTMENT WHO WERE TRAINED ON SAIPAN FOR A FEW WEEKS IN THE
INSTALLATION OF THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM ARE PRESENTLY ENGAGED IN THE
INSTALLATION PROJECT. THEY ARE DANNY LIKJAR AND NINA NAPTALI.
THE SYSTEM WILL BE COMPLETED BY THE FIRST WEEK OF NOVEMBER.

SAIPAN, OCTOBER 1, (MNS)---HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E.
JOHNSTON HAS ANNOUNCED THE APPOINTMENT OF ELIAS W. THOMAS
OF PONAPE AS THE NEW CHIEF OF THE BROADCAST DIVISION. HE
REPLACES GEORGE T. CALLISON, WHO HAS BEEN ASSIGNED TO WORK

AS A SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS.

SUBSEQUENTLY WORKED HIS WAY UP TO ACTING STATION MANAGER FOR OVER A YEAR QV1965 AND THEN AS A STATION MANAGER IN 1967. IN 1970, HE MOVED TO SAIPAN, WHERE HE WAS NAMED ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER FOR THE BROADCAST DIVISION. TWO YEARS LATER HE WAS APPOINTED ASSISTANT CHIEF.

THOMAS GRADUATED FROM PONAPE ISLANDS CENTRAL SCHOOL (PICS) IN 1960. HE RECEIVED TRAINING AT THE EAST-WEST CENTER IN HONOLULU IN RADIO PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT IN THE SUMMER OF 1964. HE AND HIS WIFE, MISO, HAVE SEVEN CHILDREN.

IN HIS POSITION AS SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS, CALLISON WILL CONCENTRATE ON REVIEWING AND DEVELOPING PLANS TO UPGRADE THE QUALITY OF RADIO BROADCASTING CAPABILITY.
