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MARSHALL ISLANDS DISTRICT
10 year Capital Improvement Budget

BASE ASSUMPTIONS

[11/73]

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This Capital Improvement budget is designed based on the following assumptions:

- ✓ 1. That no financial ceilings are imposed and the district need is the only limiting factor;
2. That an appropriate operations budget would be forthcoming for all proposed projects;
3. That the importation of the required skills from outside Micronesia would not be regulated if the required skill were not available on a local basis;
4. That the public and private sectors will become increasingly less interdependent, and private capital in some instances will buy out and continue operations of specific Government projects once started. Example: municipal transportation services;
5. That each population center, by inflow of Government capital will be stimulated to grow in certain directions to reduce investments. These growth patterns recognize the physical assets of each atoll. *induce*
6. The population will continue to migrate to the population centers but education/health services will be upgraded by technical means to hold the population on the outer islands;
7. That a major emphasis is placed on the use of advanced technology in the fields of transportation, communication and utility systems;
8. That international laws will be passed to allow a minimum of 50-mile and possibly a 200-mile national water limit;
9. That no travel restriction for tourist travel to Micronesia will be imposed and all necessary merchandising will be done on a Trust Territory wide basis;
10. That Kwajalein Missile Range will continue to operate and will grow as a major employer of all skills;
- ✓ 11. That the Trust Territory will continue as a political entity composed of 6 districts.

Based on the above, this budget outlines some major changes from our present 5-year C.I.P. Plan. The emphasis remains the same: to make the Marshalls economically independent and self-sustaining, but within a shorter time frame and at a higher standard of living.

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POPULATION CENTER GROWTH PROJECTIONS

The assumption was made in the preparation of this budget projection that the major population centers would be stimulated in certain directions of growth by the type of C.I.P. projects constructed in that particular atoll. The projected growth patterns have in certain instances commenced, due to past physical and political factors, for example in Majuro. In all instances, and especially these atolls presently with very limited development, projections are based on the physical characteristics of the respective atoll, location, land area, soil type, rainfall, etc., and the necessity for complementing growth patterns to allow the district to develop as a whole. Further, the Marshalls District's relation to the entire Trust Territory to recognize the interdependence of the districts is incorporated with the assumption that complementing growth patterns will take place in the other five districts.

The present district center at Majuro Atoll shall continue to be the administrative center as well as the transportation and communication center. International class "C" vessels will transship from Majuro on interdistrict ships to the subdistrict centers. Limited industrial, mainly fishing and assemblage operations, will grow at Majuro Atoll.

Jaluit, as a subdistrict center is envisioned to become the center of a Marshalls fishing industry due to its physical location in the southern latitudes. Further, the major high school is envisioned to stimulate a population surge and spin-off businesses will bring a population in close confines to necessitate utility and other public facilities. To stimulate the fishing/mariculture industry, a marine laboratory (with a cousin operation in Majuro) and an experimental farm is envisioned within the Atoll. Fishing and mariculture shall be major industries to the District.

Wotje, with its geographical location central to the District, is envisioned to become the center of advanced education, with the two major fields to which the Marshalls are best oriented, a marine academy and a medical center, being established as the professional components of a Micronesian College. Agriculture, in terms of truck farming, should be a base of immediate economic growth and continue to grow as the tourist industry increases.

Kwajalein Atoll, while establishing an economic base in agriculture and mariculture in the northern most islands, will in effect continue to be a labor magnet of all skills due to the existence of the U.S. Missile Range. This, of course, assumes it (the Missile Range) will exist for a period greater than 10 years. Additionally, sea mining is envisioned to become a viable industry toward the end of the 10 year period.

Of the outer islands, the major growth is foreseen to be agriculture through more productive crops and greater world needs for copra through advanced technology. All marine operations should have sub-bases for baiting and mariculture in the islands, but administration and industrialization of such is envisioned on a commute basis with increased transportation facilities.

Tourism is envisioned as a major inflow of capital and creator of job opportunities. The District and Subdistrict Centers are envisioned as stepping-off

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points for more primitive and "native" type tourist attractions on the islands away from these centers. This is especially true of Arno Atoll, Eniwetok, Bikini and Maloelap.
