MICRONESIAN STATUS TALKS CLOSE

The seventh round of Micronesian Status Negotiations ended November 21 as United States and Micronesian representatives met in closing plenary session at the Department of the Interior.

The U.S. delegation headed by Ambassador F. Haydn Williams,
The President's Personal Representative for Micronesian Status
Negotiations and the Congress of Micronesia's Joint Committee on
Future Status lead by Senator Lazarus Salii have been negotiating
the terms of a future compact of free association which would
replace the existing strategic trusteeship arrangement administered
by the United States.
