

has in these and other areas of federal law, so that  
we can make the necessary recommendations to you  
about at the next session (probably April/May) to  
avoid the same difficulties which we are complaining  
about. The Bureau - just as a matter of alerting  
you and making your advice and participation.

3) On some speculative basis, I would  
be interested in knowing your reaction to  
participating deeply in the kind of legal planning,  
government reorganization, Constitutional Convention, etc.  
proposals outlined in Tab X of our report. Based on  
preliminary indications, the U.S. may be willing to  
fund the Commission for these purposes and I am  
looking for a talented, aggressive, mid-level associate  
(chiefly a funded political scientist) to take the lead in  
this phase of the work. It would not be an  
exclusive assignment, i.e. while prosecuting, but it  
will require a substantial commitment of time over a  
period of 18-24 months beginning sometime next  
year. And, when things get started, it would entail hiring and  
supervising consultants in a variety of fields, trying to  
do the necessary, and a lot of tough intellectual and political  
work. Please read it over and let me know your initial  
reaction when I see you, hopefully, in December 21.
