Thank you for your letter -- the check has been banked, thus saving WCP from bankruptcy!!

Have checked your airline reservations for Christmas and they are, as of today's date at least, unchanged. They can give no guarantee yet, however, they won't be changed before Christmas due to the energy crisis. However, I will get our "pinch hitter" to OK the firm's check to pay for them!
