Subject: Establishment of the Trust Territory Task Force on Education for Self-Government

On November 30, 1978 High Commissioner Edward W. Schnaton established a Task Force on the program of Education for Self-Government, with a territory-wide function, which was approved by members of the U. S. Status Delegation and representatives of the Joint Committee on Future Status of the Congress of Micronesia who were meeting in Honolulu in early October, 1978. 
