## A PRIVATE, NON PROFIT CORPORATION

## A. ØKGANIZATIØN CREATION

THE MSC PROPOSAL SUGGESTS SEVERAL METHODS FOR CREATIONS OF THE LEGAL ENTITY:

- I. Under TTPI Code, the High Commissioner would grant a charter of incorporation and the Registrar of Corporations would prescribe such rules and regulations as are deemed necessary
- II. COM could adopt a model corporations act or authorize district legislatures to charter copporations such as proposed by MSC
- III. Secretary of the Interdor could authorize application of a model coporation act for purposes of MSC proposal

## Comments

Either of these suggestions is acceptable, and it offers no basis for objection by the USG except for practical policy considerations. Consequently, it would be preferable that the COM be the agent to authorize district legislatures to form and organizae coprrations as proposed by the MSC. Should the COM legislation be vetoed for any reason and US executive action is taken, the Secretary of the Interior could authorize the High Commissioner to either grant charters of incorporation for corporate bodies designated bythe district legislatures or authorize the district legislatures to formulate coporate bodies such as proposed by the MSC.

## B. ORGANIZATION
