I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The District Division of Community Development is an activity within the District Department of Public Affairs of the Marianas District Administration. This Division (including GRANT-IN-AID Administration) is under the direction and supervision of the District Community Development Officer, a Trust Territory citizen, who receives technical directions and supervision from the Chief, Division of Community Development at Headquarters, and general supervision and direction from the Director, District Department of Public Affairs.

Grants-In-Aid, as here used, refers to the administrative organization within the District Community Development to administer the District level aspects of the Trust Territory Grant-In-Aid program, and does not include actual "grant funds", which are funded at the Headquarters level.
