I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The District Department of Education is composed of four major activities; Administration, Elementary Education, Secondary Education and Special Programs. The District Department of Education is part of the District Administration for the Mariana Islands District, and is headed by District Director of Education, a Trust Territory citizen, who receives overall general direction, supervision and administrative support from the District Administrator of the Marianas District. Technical direction, supervision and programs guidance are received from the Headquarters Director of Education. The District Department of Education has had long standing goals in Teachers Education and upgrading of Secondary schools. Curriculum upgrading for all grade levels and re-direction of the English program in the Secondary Schools are also program goals for the next several years. This Department operates eleven (11) Elementary Schools serving 3,030 students from grades 1 through 8 and two (2) secondary schools serving 1,127 students. Tinian School has grades 1 through 9 and Rota has grades 1 through 12.
