I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The District Department of Public Safety is comprised of the Police Detachment and the Fire Division. District Headquarters of the Department is located in the Civic Center at Saipan, with sub-stations (both Police and Fire) located at Tinian and Rota, in the out-islands.

The District Police Force is a detachment of the "Micronesia Police", consisting of an armed, uniformed and trained group of men divided into district detachments, as specified in the Trust Territory Code. The District Department of Public Safety (comprised of both Police and Fire) is headed by the District Chief of Police, a Trust Territory citizen, who is appointed by the High Commissioner, based on nominations by the District Administrator. The Chief of Police performs his duties under the general direction and supervision of the District Administrator, with technical supervision and direction provided by the Superintendent of Public Safety (Headquarters) and the Trust Territory Attorney-General.

Police and Fire Sub-stations are operated at Rota and Tinian, with essentially the same general types of police and fire functions as at the District Center, but of a smaller scale. Supervision over out-islands public safety activities are provided by the District Chief of Police, working through the District Administrator's Representative involved.
