I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The District Radio Station began operation on March 27, 1965. The first station was built at Micro Beach in the Garapan Area of Saipan, assigned the call sign of "KJQR", a power output of 1,000 watts. The old station was built with a \$10,000 supplemental fund provided by the Mariana Islands District Legislature in February 1964. The new station, atop Rapugao Hill, behind the Navy Hill residential area, was completely funded by the Trust Territory and was put into operation in April 1971.

This activity is headed by a District Broadcast Manager, who is a Trust Territory citizen. Headquarters provides technical support such as providing electronic technicians, purchasing major equipments, etc., without charges of this account. The District Public Affairs Officer provides day-to-day administrative supervision for the District Administrator.
