I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Primary administrative objective of the District Division of Land Management is to establish and implement proper procedures for the continuing development and protection of public and private lands in the best interest of all District Inhabitants.

In general, the areas within which Land Management personnel have a principal interest and responsibility are those related to homesteading, land claims and title determinations, and government land leases and exchanges; and in addition to the foregoing, there is continuing and increasing need for capability in producing preliminary engineering feasibility studies, site planning and development, and systematic enforcement of building/zoning regulations. Although the need for all of these highly specialized and technical services has always existed, in the past two years, the demand has more than doubled, although the staff and equipment has remained essentially the same-even decreasing in some respect.
