## I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Mariana District Environmental Health Services is a component of the Mariana District Health Services. It is headed by the Chief District Sanitarian, who receive overall supervision and direction from the District Director of Health Services. Technical direction, supervision and guidance is being provided to this activity by TT Headquarters Chief of Environmental Health Services. The main office of the District Environmental Health Division is maintained at the Dr. Torres Hospital, with field offices in Rota and Tinian. The Northern Mariana Islands services are performed by visitation by the Sanitation representative on field trip.

Basically, the function and objectives of the Environmental Health Division is to improve sanitary conditions throughout the District as an integral part of a public health program of improving the health and well-being of the populace. This includes inspections of food-handling and other public facilities to prevent disease generating and spreading conditions, sewage and other waste disposal policing, vector controls, etc..
