## I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The District Legislative Liaison Division is an activity within the District Public Affairs organization of the Marianas District Administration, whose administrative jurisdiction extends throughout the Marianas Islands. In general, this activity serves as liaison between the executive and legislative branches of the government at the territorial, district and local level. It is involved in the planning, development and coordination of the District Administration's legislative program. It conducts research, plans and actively participates in the formulation and the implementation of the administration's legislative program. It also prepares analysis and reports on legislative developments within the Trust Territory and disseminates such information to public officials and the general public.

In addition, this activity is responsible for coordinating the conduct of elections, estimating costs, preparing election materials and carrying out all other activities incidental to the elections. It is also responsible for all direct or incidental activities which are legislative in nature.
