I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Division of Civic Affairs is one of the five division within the District Department of Public Affairs, established as the implementing agency for political education programs within the Marianas District. By nature of its importance in this area, the division maintains close liaison with the Marianas District Legislature, Municipal Councils and officials, with the aim of conducting programs of political education and information designed to the needs of the people of the Marianas District. This division advises the District Director of Public Affairs and the District Administrator in matters pertaining to the basic objectives of providing a coordinated and concerted programs of political and governmental education and information. Aside from receiving technical direction from its Headquarters counterpart, the division is directly under the general adminis trative supervision of the District Director of Public Affairs.

Although this division's major role is in political education, it is charged with the responsibility of developing and disseminating governmental and political information concerning various aspects of political development and events within the Marianas District and the entire Trust Territory. Much emphasis would dwell on the structure, function and responsibility of the various levels of Governments (territorial, district and municipal) about which proper dissemination can be effected through the use of all available communications media.
