

Guam, Marianas Meet On Status

The first in a series of meetings between the Political Status Commission of the Marianas and of Guam occurred here Saturday in the Guam Legislative Building in Agana.

The discussion covered Guam's experience with U.S. military policy, administration and citizenship. Guam's experience was compared with that of the Northern Marianas, which differ from Guam in political status since they are part of the U.S. Strategic Trust Territories.

At the meeting's conclusion, Guam Sen. Frank Lujan, chairman of the five-man Guam Political Status Commission, said both committees in the future talks would examine the possibility of Guam's reintegration with the Northern Marianas.

The 12-man Marianas Political Status Commission was chaired by Marianas Sen. Edward D.L.G. Pangelinan.
