SUBJ: MARIANAS POLITICAL STATUS DEVELOPMENTS

1. (U) MARIANAS POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION (MPSC) CHAIRED BY SEN EDWARD PANGELINAN TRAVELED TO GUAM SAT MARCH 30 ON INVITATION GUAM POLITICAL XXXX STATUS COMMISSION HEADED BY SEN FRANK LUJAN TO DISCUSS MATTERS OF R MUTUAL INTEREST. WHILE THERE HAVE BEEN NUMEROUS CONTACTS BETWEEN MEMBERS OF TWO BXXXRXXXXXX DELEGATIONS, SATURDAY'S MEETING

WAS DESCRIBED TO PRESS AS "FIRST IN A SERIES." ACCORDING TO RECENTER

PACIFIC DAILY NEWS TODAY APR 2, LUJAN SAID BOTH COMMITTEES IN FUTURE

TALKS WOULD EXAMINE POSSIBILITY OF GUAM'S REINTEGRATION WITH NORTHERS

MARIANAS.

PRIVATELY COMMENTING 2. (C) PANGELINAN HAS **RRXXXEEXX** CONFIRMED ABOVE STATEMENT, **BEMEENXXNE** THAT REUNIFIACTION IS "INEVITABLE, PERHA<sup>Q</sup>S WITHIN TWENTY YEARS." HE THOUGHT IT "BETTER TO TALK ABOUT IT NOW."

3. (C) IN RESPONSE TO MY QUERY TO HIM APR 1 AS TO GUAM MEETING, RANGEL PANGELINAN SAID GUAM STATUS COMMISSION M VERY CONCERNED ABOUT MILITARY/ CIVILIAN RELATIONS. MEXSAXEXX HE SAID: THEY HAVE HAD A BAD EXPERIENCE AND CAUTION US ABOUT THE PROBLEM." I POINTED TO COURSE OF CURRENT NEGOTIATIONS AND STEPS UNDER WAY AND EXX CONTEMPLATED FOR COOPERATIVE

ACTION ON THIS SUBJECT WITH REGARD TO NORTHERN MARIANAS (PLANS IN WHICH HE PARTICIPATED IN RECENT HONOLULU MEETING WITH AMBASSADOR WILLIAMS). HIS RESPONSE WAS A QUICK DISMISSAL: "YES, YES, BUT THE PEOPLE ON GUAM HAVE GIVEN US SOME TIMELY WARNINGS." COMMENT: PANGELINAN'S PROCLIVITY, LIKE THAT OF MANY MICRONESIANS, TO TAILOR HIS STATEMENTS AND APPARENT ATTITUDES TO HIS AUDIENCE IS EVIDENT AND, I BELIEVE, MUST BE TAKEN INTO EME CONSIDERATION IN OUR REKEXE RELATION<u>-</u> SHIPS OUT HERE.

5. (C) I LEARNED WHILE ON GUAM THAT ONE OF PRINCIPAL COMPLAINTS OF GUAM STATUS COMMISSION BROUGHT OUT IN MEETING WAS CONCERNED WITH CONTROL OF UTILITIES ON LAND USED BY MILITARY. COMMENT: WHILE CIRCUMSTANCES DIFFER, THIS MAY FORESHADOW AREA OF POTENTIAL CONCERN IN OUR NEGOTIA-TIONS WITH MPSC ON LAND USE.

6. (C) COMMENT: THERE ARE LIKELY TO BE CONTINUING KMX CONTACTS BETWEEN THE TWO NEIGHBORING STATUS COMMISSIONS. GIVEN THE EVIDENT ANTI-U.S. SLANT OF THE GUAM GROUP, AS JUDGED BY ITS RELEASES CARRIED IN PDN UNDER LUJAN'S NAME, THE EFFECT MAY POSE SOME PROBLEMS FOR US IN DEALING WITH THE MPSC. (NOTE: APPARENTLY RECOGNIZING THEIR PROPAGANDA NATURE, PDN HAS NOW DECLINED CARRY FURTHER LUJAN STATUS-RELATED ESSAYS AS NEWS; LATEST ONE LAST WEEK APPEARED AS PAID ADVERTISEMENT.)

7. (C) IN CONVERSATOON APR 1, MARIANAS DISTAD FRANK ADA TOLD ME HE PLANNED TO MOVE "THIS WEEK" TO ACTIVATE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC LAND AND JOINT ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON MILITARY-CIVILIAN RELATIONS AND PLANNING --THE TWO BODIES AGREED UPON IN HONOLULU TALKS.
