SAIPAN---The Mariana Islands District Legislature Act Number 60-1974 introduced by Honorable Daniel T. Muna of Saipan, was approved by the Marianas District Administrator Francisco C. Ada on April 2, 1974. Upon approval by the District Administrator, it become District law #4-53 and is now in effect.

This act after being approved by the District Administrator and becoming law makes it illegal for any member of the Mariana Islands District Legislature to accept gifts, gratuities or anything of value for himself because of an official formance. It is now unlawful for any Mariana Islands District Legislature member to directly or indirectly ask, demand, exact, solicit, seek. accept, receive, or agree to receive anything of value for himself for or because of any official act performed or to be performed by him.

Any member who violates

this Act, upon conviction, will be fined not more than \$1,000.00 or be imprisoned for not more than two years, or both. In addition to the above penalty, conviction of violating this Act will be ground for impeachment.
