SOME SEEM NERVOUS AT THE THOUGHT. INDICATIONS ARE, I BELIEVE, THAT THE POLITICAL AND EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE WE HAVE AFFORDED MICRONESIANS OVER THE YEARS OF OUR TRUSTEESHIP, TOGETHER HITH THEIR OWN INTELLIGENCE, HAVE PREPARED THEM FOR SELF-GOVERNMENT. SUCH EVOLUTION WHILE NOT REMOVING ALL THE PROBLEMS INVOLVED IN U.S.-MICRONESIAN RELATIONS HOULD MOVE OUR RELATIONS ONTO A SOUNDER, MORE PRACTICAL AND MUTUALLY ACCEPTABLE BASIS BY GIVING MICRONESIANS THE RESPONSIBILITIES WHICH THEY MUST EVENTUALLY HANDLE, AND WHICH HOULD CHALLENGE THEIR OWN ABILITY. INTEREST AND INITIATIVE. (C) THE CLASSIC DUESTION "WHAT IS MICRONESIA7" WILL HAVE TO BE 7. ANSWERED BY MICRONESIANS THEMSELVES IN PRACTICAL TERMS OF A POLITICAN RELATIONSHIP ACCEPTABLE TO THEIR DIVERSE INTERESTS. THE CONSTITUTI-ONAL CONVENTION WILL PROVIDE THE OPPORTUNITY.
