Coleman said: "It is fitting that Law Day be devoted to this worthy purpose, for without laws and independent courts, the freedoms we enjoy would be meaningless.
"To each new generation of Micronesia citizens comes a new opportunity and responsibility to provide new leadership, fresh wisdom and foresight for Micronesia," Coleman added.

Coleman said that as Micronesia moves toward self-government the responsibilities of leadership will pass to today's generation of youth. The Deputy HiCom stated that the 12 th annual territorial observance of Law Day Micronesia on Wednesday, May 1, will be directed toward youth and the law

In emphasizing the importance of law to youth, Coleman said every effort will be made to assist Micronesian young men and women, who comprise nearly
one-half of our population, in gaining a better understanding of the law and the legal process and their leadership responsibilities.
"We can be justly proud of Micronesia's youth for they are playing an active role in the continuing grosth of our Territory.

These young citizens are learning the ideals of Micronesia by taking a concerned interest in community action programs embracing student government, civic, social, business, religious and educational activities," Coleman said.
The Deputy HiCorn concluded by saying: "I am confident that our youth will carry out the responsibilities that will soon be thrust upon them with great credit to our islands."
