## TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE U.S. -MARIANAS CIVIL/MILITARY RELATIONS ADVISORY COUNCIL

1. Purpose.

On a continuing basis, this Advisory Council will be concerned with civil-military relations, problems and issues connected with the stablishment and functioning of U.S. military installations in the Mariana Islands. The Council meetings will both provides point of contact for obtaining information and act as a forum wherein the needs, requests, ideas and suggestions of the people can be made known and discussed.

The Joint Advisory Council, will, as agreed to in meetings, make recommendations to the Office of the District Administrator, the Marianas Political Status Commission and the U.S. Military Services and Commands having interests in the Marianas.
